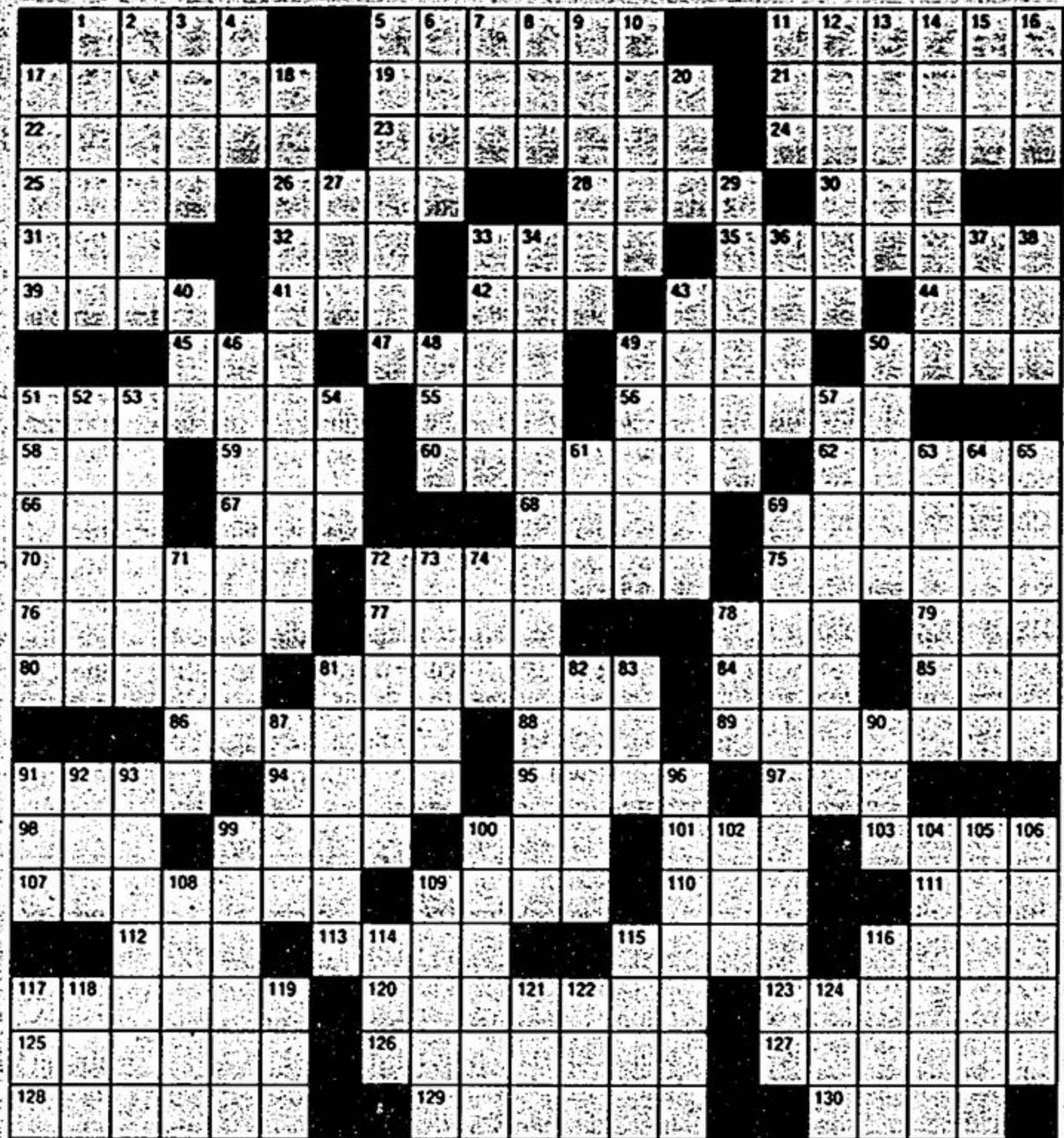

**LANDFILL SEARCH UPDATE**  
*Preferred Site Chosen*

**Dear Metro/York Resident:**  
As you may know, the Interim Waste Authority Ltd. (IWA) has been searching for an environmentally-suitable landfill site in Metropolitan Toronto/York Region to handle waste over the next 20 years. When operating, this site will be used to dispose of waste which remains after Reduction, Reuse and Recycling (3Rs) efforts have been aggressively implemented.

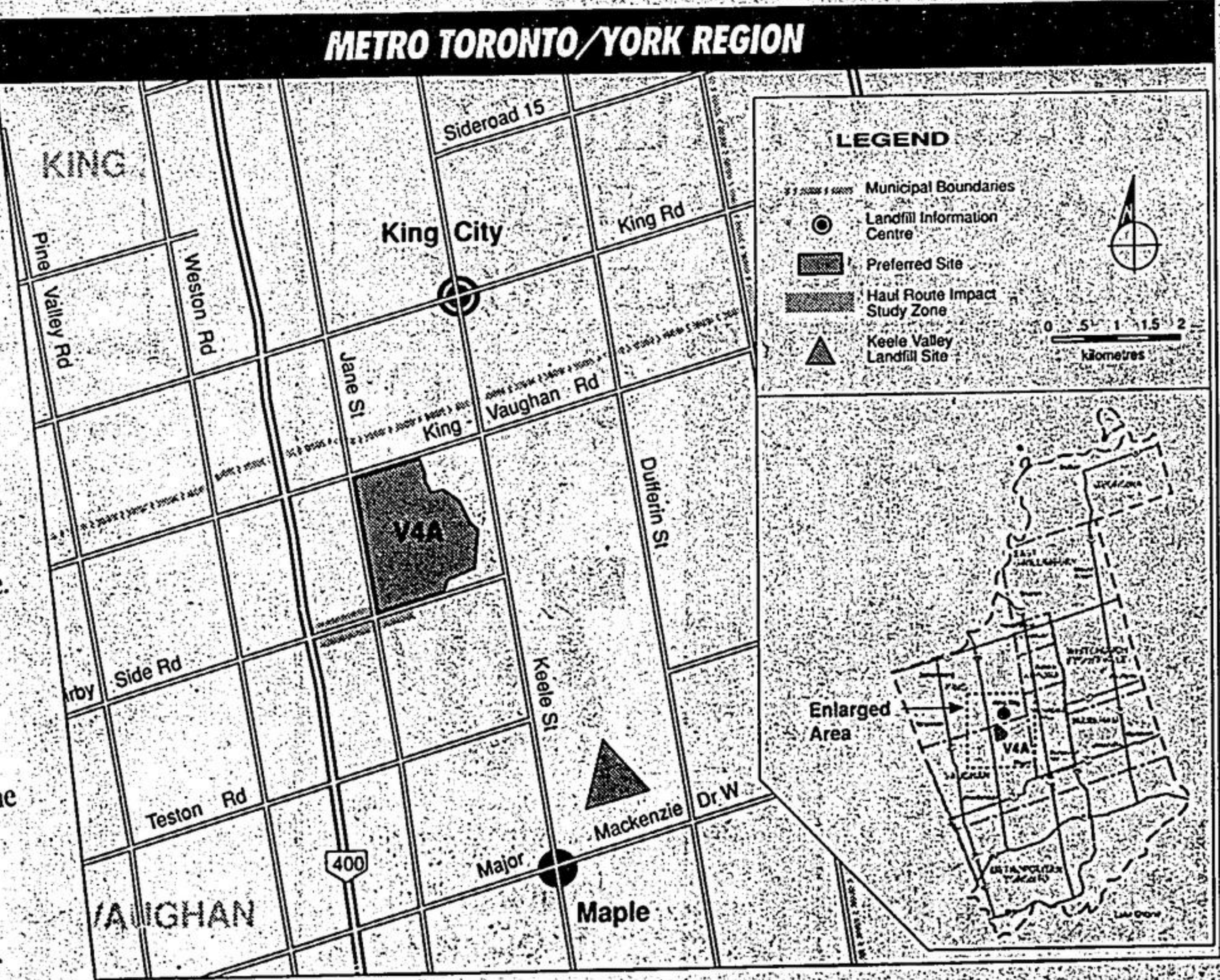
**Detailed Environmental Studies**  
Following detailed environmental studies and public consultation, the IWA has recently identified the preferred landfill site in Metro/York. Our environmental investigations included drilling to determine soil and groundwater conditions, and in depth study of biological, agricultural and surface water resources.

**Public Consultation**  
In selecting the preferred site, we have seriously considered public comments and concerns. We heard concern about the potential effects of landfilling on people and water quality, and adjusted the ranks and weights of the criteria used to choose the preferred site. We heard that people needed more details about compensation, and released our *Impact Management and Compensation Policy*. We also provided participant funding to assist community groups and municipalities in reviewing our work.

**Next Steps**  
The next phase of the landfill site search involves additional investigations on and near the preferred site. We will continue to seek your input as this work progresses. Key components in our public consultation program will include dialogue with affected residents, and the formation of a community committee to address local concerns. Over the 120-day review period which is now under way, we encourage you to call our Public Information Office or visit the IWA Information Centre.

The final decision on approval of the preferred site rests with the Joint Board, which includes members of the Environmental Assessment and Ontario Municipal Boards.
