Famous People Players in Latcham fundraiser



Tickets are still available for the Latcham Gallery's presentation of Famous People Players, the acclaimed blacklight theatre company appearing at Markham Theatre Friday, Dec. 10 and Saturday, Dec. 11. The show incorporates music, folklore, fairy tales and incredible life sized characters of favorite stars of stage and screen in a breathtaking display of color and light. Proceeds from ticket sales go to support the Latcham Gallery, one of only two public art galleries in York Region, which offers a wide range of programs for all age groups in York, Durham and surrounding areas. Art exhibitions, lectures, workshops, art classes and films are just some of the events featured at the gallery, which is facing unprecedented cuts in funding over the next five years. Tickets for the show are \$16 for adults, \$14 for students and seniors and \$10 for children under 12. A special family rate of \$46 is offered for two adults and two children. Show times are 7:30 p.m. Friday and 1 p.m. Saturday. Tickets are available by calling the Markham Theatre Box Office, 479-0201. The gallery's current exhibition - The Marriage of Heart and

Mind - features paintings by Christina Luck, who will give a slide presentation and talk about her work tomorrow (Thursday) at 7:30 p.m. at the gallery. Admission is free.

FIGHT CONTINUES

With the election of the new Liberal government, a 30 day freeze was imposed on the rural post office closings announced by the Progressive Conservatives. "The freeze expires Dec. 11 and after that we're going to have a meeting with (Liberal MP) Jag Bhaduria," advised Stouffville resident Lynda Norman, a member of the group fighting the local closure. Media coverage has been excellent, said Norman. A letter, sent from Prime Minister Jean Chretien's office to Rural Dignity in Nova Scotia just prior to the election, has added to the group's optimism.
