Ontario Ranger program deadline in January

The Ministry of Natural Resources is inviting young people who love the outdoors to apply now to the Ontario Ranger Program.

Don Cousens, MPP Markham said, "This is a great opportunity for young people who are seeking a summer job. It won't be long before the few opportunities this summer are taken by those who have started early in their search."

The deadline for submitting an application is Jan. 31. To be eligible for the 1994 season, applicants must be in their 17th year, born between August 1, 1976 and December 31, 1977. They must also reside in Ontario and be attending school.

The program runs for eight weeks beginning in late June or early July and provides opportunities for young people to learn first-hand about fish, wildlife, parks, water, land and forest management. Participants will undertake a variety of activities ranging from planting trees to creating portages. Ontario Rangers earn approximately \$36 a day and work five days a week. They also receive free room and board and a partial subsidy for travel costs.

Applications are available from secondary schools or from local Ministry of Natural Resources offices. You may also obtain one by contacting the Youth Programs Office, Box 6900, Peterborough, Ontario K9J 7B1 or by calling collect (705) 740-1208.
