The Municipal Elections Act provides for the registration of all candidates for the purpose of disclosing election contributions and expenses.

Prospective candidates for the offices of Mayor, Ward Councillors and York Region Board of Education Trustee are required to register with the Municipal Clerk for the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, no earlier than January 1st, 1994, and no later than nomination day, prior to accepting any contributions.

Prospective candidates for York Region Roman Catholic Separate School Board Trustee should register with the Municipal Clerk for the Town of Aurora at 100 John West Way, Aurora.

Prospective candidates for York Region Roman Catholic Separate School Board (French Language Section) Trustees should register with the Municipal Clerk for the Town of Markham at 101 Town Centre Boulevard, Markham.

opening, including stand-up comics from Yuk Yuk's, representing the comedy cabaret's first appearance in the Stouffville area. In the spring Hakonson moved his sports clothing business into the building, allowing him to conduct business under one roof. While his new venture has kept him busy, he has still found time to stir things up periodically in council chambers. This fall Hakonson accused the town of playing favorites after he had been refused an extension of hours under the noise bylaws, and then learned that the neighboring flea market had been granted an extension for Oktoberfest.

In October, Hakonson approached council requesting noise bylaw extensions to cover at least three outdoor functions he plans to hold at the facility next year. On this occasion, officials gave him the green light, noting that he had made an early effort to go through the right channels and therefore deserved the extension.
