December

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville comes under police scrutiny following some citizens' complaints to the force's Project 80, which has been investigating municipal corruption across the region since 1990.

The York-Durham Heritage Railway Association receives provincial approval to run a tourist railway line between Stouffville and Uxbridge, which is scheduled to start operations in the summer of 1995.

Waste Management Inc., a Mississauga-based company which owns the abandoned landfill site on Hwy 48, suggests the Interim Waste Authority consider the location as a provincial dumpsite.

AAA Ace Taxi of Markham is chosen to act as the Mobility Transit Committee's taxi service for disabled citizens in a year-long pilot project for the community.

The installation of traffic lights at the intersection of Bloomington Sideroad and McCowan Road are approved
