

# Easter food drive on once again

The Whitchurch-Stouffville Foodbank is once again appealing to the community for help with its Easter food drive. "Things have been going really well," noted Esther Powell, who heads up the volunteer organization. "The town is very supportive and people have been generous with food donations, as well as money. We're thankful for the steady flow of food that comes in." However, the number of people using the food bank is up and organizers want to ensure that sufficient supplies are on hand over the Easter period.

Those who use the facility tend to be very responsible about it, only asking for help in times of real necessity, stressed Powell. "When they're in need they make use of the bank, but when the need isn't there, they don't." While all non-perishable food items are welcome, the food bank would particularly appreciate donations of canned meat, fish, fruit and vegetables, pasta sauces, tea and coffee. "The local schools have been wonderful," she said. "The Progress Club has been very helpful to us and pretty well all the churches in town have one of our barrels and give regularly. Every week Parkview Village sends somebody up with a load of food."

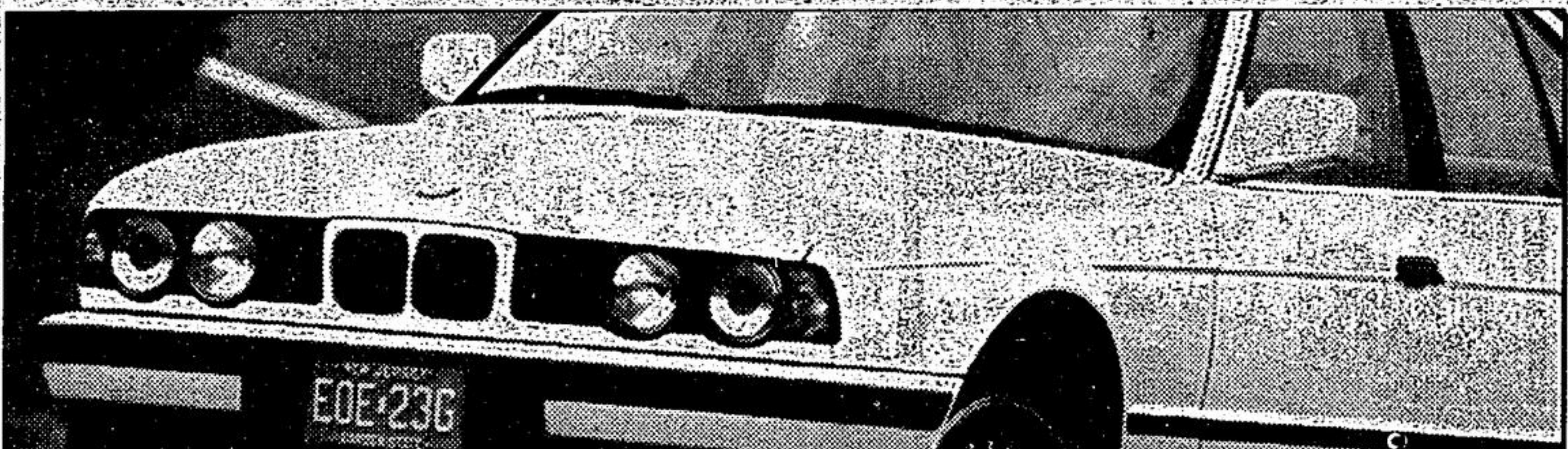
