

Town council cuts time of meetings

The town's newly-implemented council meeting roster has shaved an average of 30 minutes per month from the schedule, according to estimates compiled by the town's clerk.

According to a chart, the average meeting runs about 1 1/2 hours with its 'new' two-meetings-per-month schedule. In the old system of meeting each Tuesday, the meetings ran an average of 1 3/4 hours, the chart shows.

If the new system were to run throughout the town's fiscal year, it would shave a total of about five hours off the length of meetings. "The newer system provides greater access for the public to attend meetings" even though "there is" very little difference between the volume of items and the length of time devoted to the discussions," clerk

Michelle Skinner pointed out in her report.

The new system also allows residents to informally discuss issues early in the evening during committee and hear the outcome later during final votes as council. "The residents are not required to attend two meetings to know

the final outcome of a matter on a council in committee agenda," Skinner stated.

Skinner said the new system is more efficient and makes better use of staff time.

Council is expected to vote on whether to keep the new system or to adopt back the old system of meeting each week.

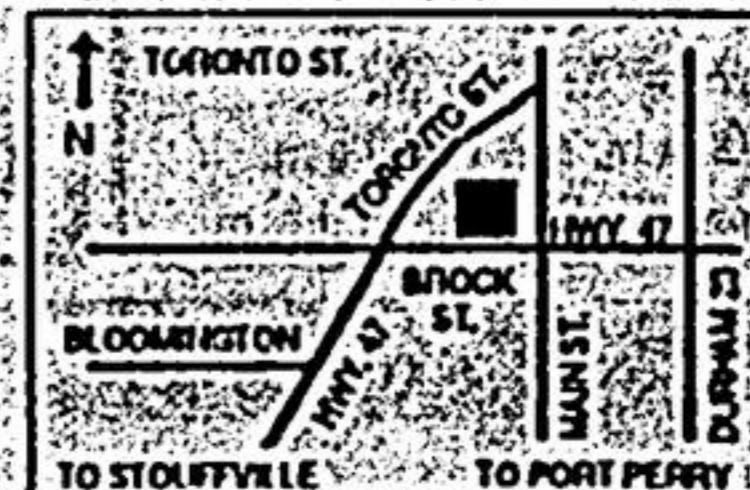
