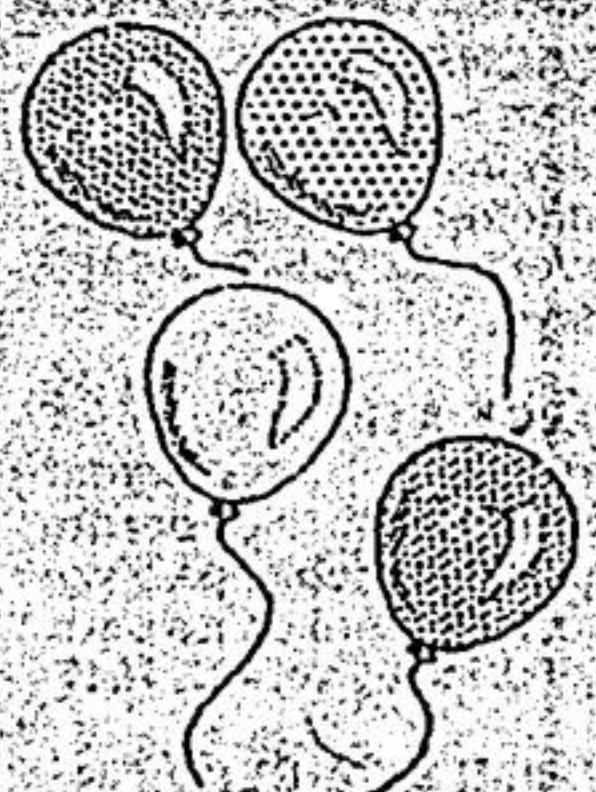

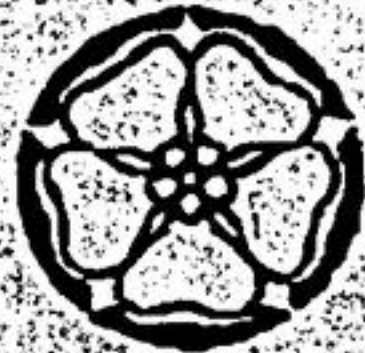

The general contractors may fax the information to Mr. Dave Snelgrove, Superintendent of Plant Services at (905) 727-0775 no later than 4:00 p.m. local time Thursday, June 23, 1994.

Only those contractors which the owner and architect deem most suitable to perform on the project, will receive tender documents for the tender call. A maximum of 15 contractors for each discipline will be chosen.

A bid bond and agreement to bond (100% performance and labour and materials bonds) would be required with all tenders.

The owner reserves the right to reject any or all tenders and will not necessarily accept the lowest tender.
