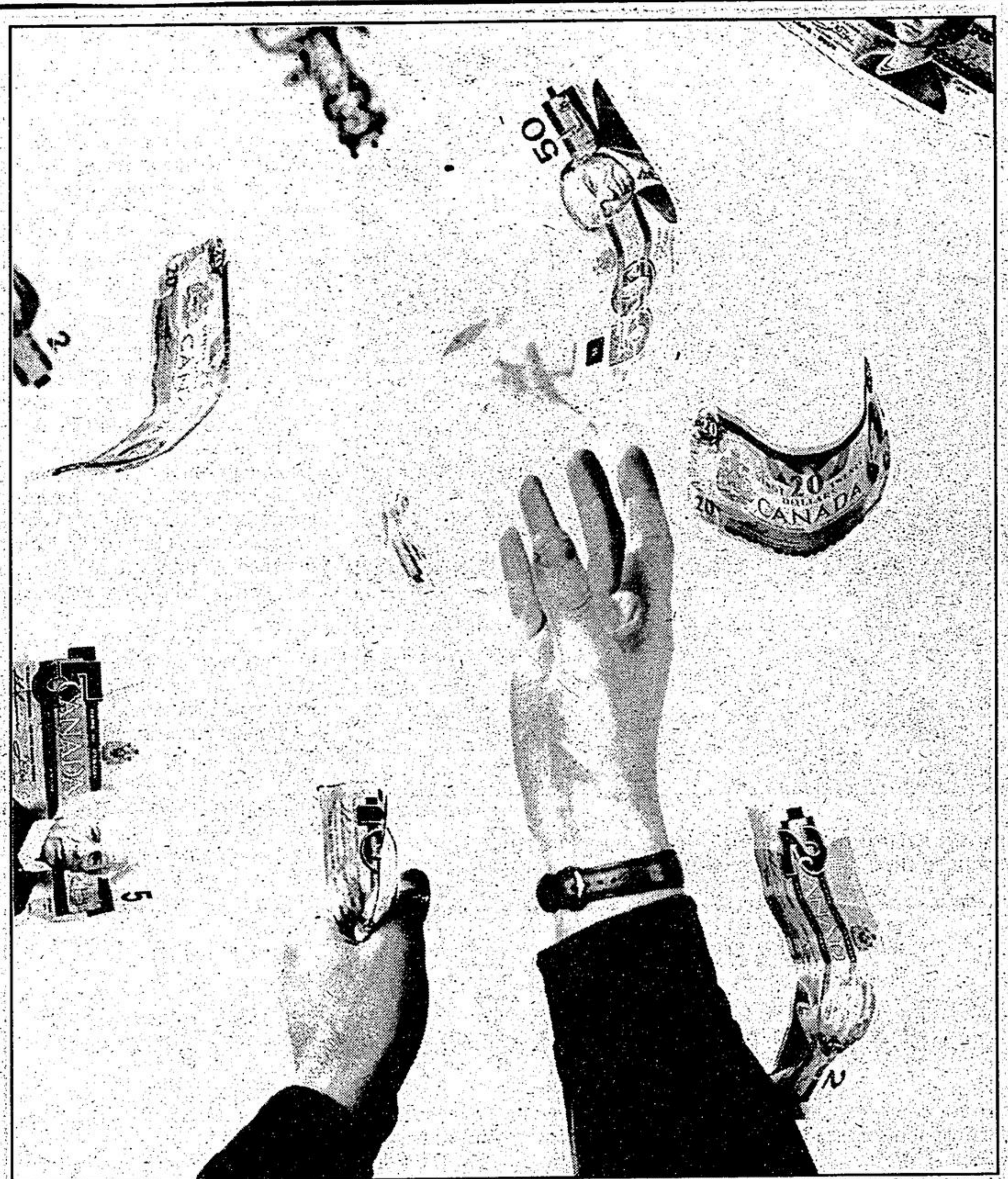

1. Parents/guardians must be public school supporters
2. To be eligible for admission in September 1993, children must have been born on or before **DECEMBER 31, 1988**. Verification of birthdate, **PROOF OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TAX SUPPORT**, and record of immunization on the Ministry of Health yellow immunization record card (available in your Doctor's office), are required.
3. If a school receives more registrations than it can accommodate, all registrations received before April 1st will be treated equally as far as date of registration is concerned. Registrations received on or after April 1st will be sequenced and the date of registrations will be the criteria used to determine which pupils may be required to attend another school unless there are sufficient volunteers to do so.
