Markham Museum open house set for Feb. 14

The Markham Museum asks visitors to put on their thinking caps on Sunday, Feb. 14 as the museum hosts its annual Open House from 1 to 4 p.m.

This year's theme is "whodunit". Several behind-the-scenes areas will be opened up to give a rare glimpse into the inner workings of the museum. Visitors will be able to find out how donated artifacts are cared for and how records are being entered into a special computer database.

There will also be a special preview of the museum's plans for a new local heritage gallery. The story of Markham's development from native settlement to 1971 will be told in the new exhibit.

Although the museum is entirely devoted to the history of Markham Township, the story is currently spread throughout the museum's 25 acres.

"With this gallery," explained program co-ordinator Birgitta

MacLeod, "visitors will get an overview of how and why Markham developed into our present community."

MacLeod expects the exhibit to be "a super introduction before touring our other historic homes, shops, and transportation displays."

In the workshop, staff will show how they are building an up-dated farm wagon for wagon rides and in the church basement, refreshments, crafts and games are offered.

MacLeod advises visitors to keep their eyes and ears open as they visit different areas of the museum.

Collecting the right clues will help visitors complete the Whodunit Quiz, which could help them win one of several door prizes.

Admission is free on Sunday, Feb. 14 and there's plenty of parking. The museum is located on the west side of Hwy. 48, about 2.3 km north of Hwy. 7 (opposite McDonalds). For more information, call the Markham Museum at 294-4576.

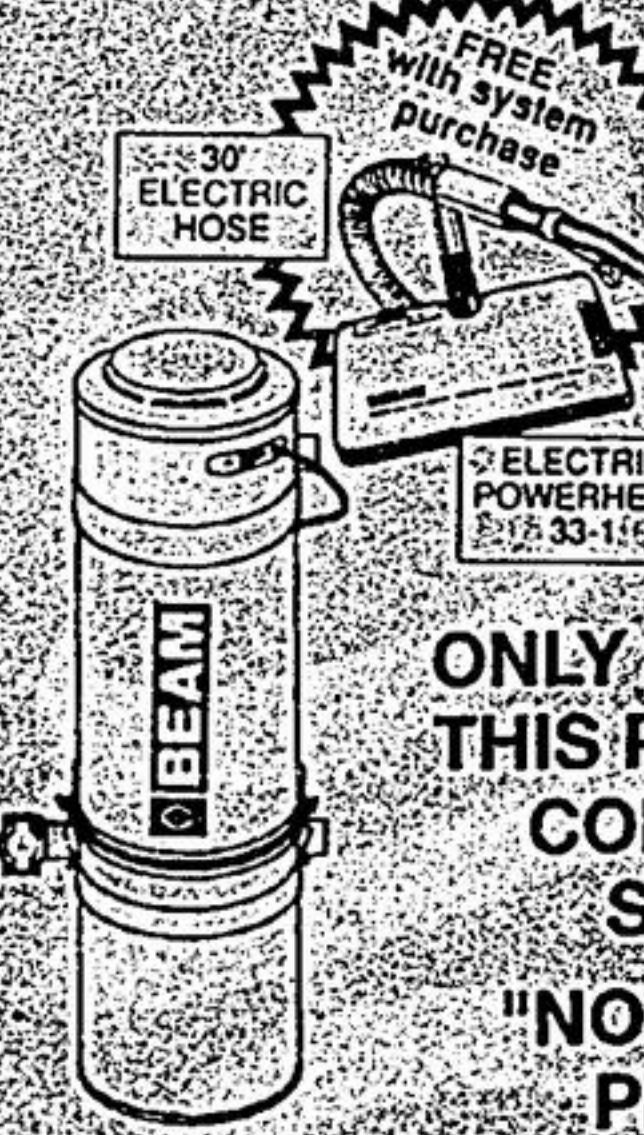

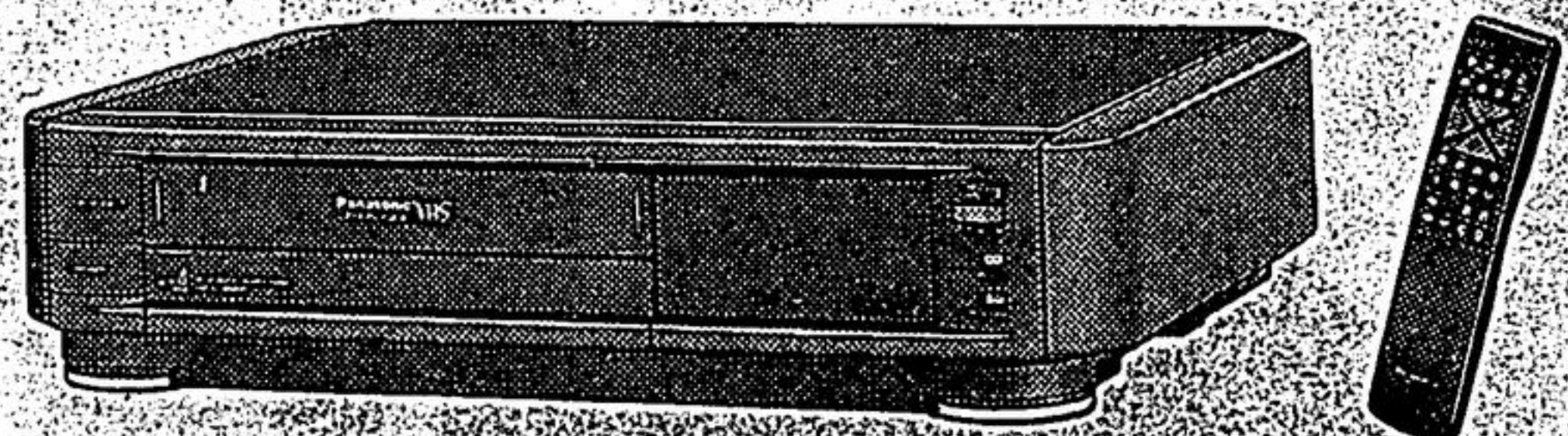
