

Splatters are splendid in sno-pitch title game

The Splatters proved to be splatter proof in the Winter 3-Pitch Tournament held by the Uxbridge Coke-Uh Huh Not! mixed sno-pitch team at the Goodwood diamonds over the weekend.

The Uxbridge area squad went undefeated in six games to claim the \$250-first prize in the co-ed competition.

The Splatters edged the Losers, another Uxbridge squad, by a 5-3 count in Sunday afternoon's championship contest.

The Losers had been anything but up to that point in the tournament, winning their first four games and earning a bye in the first playoff round.

The Clowns, a Mt. Albert unit, picked up the consolation award, defeating the Borelia Co-op from Port Perry by a 7-5 score in the runner up final.

A total of 12 teams participated in the event, which

was a fund raiser for the Coke-Uh Huh Not! team's drive to go to the Canadian National Slo-Pitch Championships in Calgary, Alta. this summer.

The team qualified for the title tournament by winning the 1992 Coors "D" Provincial Championships.

Team spokesman Ron Archibald said the winter tournament was a success, with an abundance of snow helping create the proper atmosphere.

"The emphasis was definitely on the snow in sno-pitch," said Archibald.

"Everyone had fun, and it helped us a little financially."

Archibald expressed his appreciation for the two finalists, who donated a portion of their winnings to his Calgary-bound crew.

He also praised the commitment of the tournament's six umpires, who worked for free.
