Junior Spartan cagers are defeated by a Swift team

It's been said the race goes to the swift.

After their York Region High School Athletic Association AA Junior boys basketball championship encounter with Father McGivney C.H.S. Friday, the Stouffville District Secondary School (SDSS) Spartans weren't about to argue with that timeless athletic maxim.

McGivney's 6 foot five inch top scorer Dale Swift dominated the Spartans, hooping a total of 31 points to lead the Markham team to an 83-47 victory.

Swift proved unstoppable, getting stronger as the game progressed. He scored 12 points in the fourth quarter as McGivney took the game away.

Spartan star forward Jason Reesor

typified his team's frustration in trying to stop Swift, as he fouled out of the game in the second quarter.

SDSS coach Rusty Hick acknowledged his team simply ran into a superior opponent.

"They were just bigger, faster, and stronger than we were," said Hick, whose team advanced to the final with a dramatic one point victory over Langstaff S.S. Wednesday. "It was tough to stay with them."

McGivney jumped out into the lead, taking a 22-9 advantage into the second quarter. It was 38-17 at the half.

Chris Leonard had 19 points to lead the Spartans' offensive effort. Ryan Jefferson was good for nine points, while Shawn Serjeant chipped in with four.

The McGivney crew and the

Spartans now go on to contest the Durham-York Secondary School Athletic Association championships Friday at Sutton D.H.S.

The York schools will go up against Durham's Port Perry H.S. and Brock H.S.

Hick said Monday he didn't think the Durham teams would be as strong as McGivney. He said win or lose, it had been a good season for his team.

"Just getting here is pretty important. And the Langstaff game (last Wednesday) was our biggest game of the season."

The Senior Spartans are to travel to Walkerton Thursday to contest the Ontario District High School Invitational Basketball Tournament. The competition, which is for rural area schools, runs through Saturday.
