of Canadian music.

The work is entitled, *The Canadian Mosaic: Teaching Native and Multicultural Music in the Class Room*.

It has been distributed throughout the Scarborough board schools, and includes English and French music, music of aboriginal and native peoples, as well as samples of the music of Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago, the Ukraine, India, and China.

"It is a resource book for teachers," said David. "It contains original songs in original languages, along with such things as food and customs. It involved a lot of research, and I now have a lot of multicultural friends."

David got so wrapped up in the project that after 20 years teaching music related courses, he began teaching English as a Second Language at Scarborough's Robert L. Borden Business and Technical Institute two years ago.

David is no rookie when it comes to having his work published. He has written pieces for orchestra, brass, and woodwind, as well as choral numbers. He was recently commissioned by a Scarborough choir to com-

pose a song in the Ojibway language. The piece was performed at the Kiwanis Music Festival, with David playing an Indian flute.

He has also had articles on native peoples published in various magazines.

The son of a Presbyterian minister, David willingly applies his ample musical talents to churches he is involved with. He headed up the orchestra at Grace Presbyterian Church in West Hill for several years, and has recently introduced some of his concepts of small ensembles and the like to Stouffville's St. James Presbyterian Church.

As for the future, David intends to continue on with his new found class room specialty, teaching English as a Second Language courses. He is also working on a second book of Canadian native and multicultural music. This one is to contain music of the Inuit, as well as the music of Japan, Germany, Austria, Switzerland, and Vietnam.

"There are people in my classes from all over the world," he said. "And it gives me more time outside the classroom to work on a second and third volume of the book."
