NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING CONCERNING A PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

NOTICE OF MEETING

TAKE NOTICE that the Planning and Development Committee of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Uxbridge will hold a Public Meeting on Monday the 22nd day of March, 1993 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall, 51 Toronto Street South, to make available adequate information to the public regarding, and to consider, a proposed Zoning By-law amendment pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

SUBJECT PROPERTY

The proposed Zoning By-law Amendment applies to all lands placed within the Extractive Industrial (M3) Zone and the Aggregate Processing (M5) Zone, including any Exception or Holding Zones thereunder, in Zoning by-law No. 81-19, as amended. A Key Map is not necessary as the proposed change is of a technical nature.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The proposed amendment would amend the definition of portable processing plant as contained in Section 1.123 of Zoning By-law No. 81-19. The proposed amendment would preclude the washing, screening, heating, burning and conveying of contaminated soils.

REPRESENTATION

ANY PERSON may attend the public meeting and/or make written or oral representation either in support or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law amendment. If you are unable to attend the meeting, written submissions will be received up to the time of the meeting. Written submissions should include a request for further notification, if so desired. Seven (7) days following the public meeting will be provided for the making of a formal decision with respect to the application. If deemed appropriate, the Planning the Development Committee may make available fourteen (14) days following the public meeting for the making of the written submission where such is requested at the public meeting.
