Attewell runs Kim's Metro campaign

more time with her nephews," said Attewell. The nephews are the sons of her late sister, and it was important to McDougall to be able to be close to them during their teen years, he explained.

"External Affairs is a very demanding ministry. In the last 24 months she'd been in 28 countries."

However, much as the family time will be appreciated, McDougall also had to face the fact that she simply did not have enough support across the

country to win the leadership, said Attewell.

"The support was not there. It's obvious a lot of people prefer Campbell because she represents a real change for the party," he said. "She was first elected in 1988 and doesn't carry the baggage that others do."

Attewell added that there is also a reluctance within the Conservative party to choose a leader from the Toronto area. That was also a factor in the decisions of both McDougall and Michael Wilson not to seek the

leadership.

With Campbell's popularity surging, and apparently unstoppable, Attewell said rumors of an 'Anything But Campbell' (ABC) campaign swelling within the grass roots of the party are unfounded. "According to our recent poll of 450 eligible delegates, she (Campbell) got 31 per cent on the first ballot and others got eight per cent. On the second ballot, though, she was the overwhelming choice."

Attewell said he looks at the leadership race as the start of the federal election campaign for the Tories.
