Pool Supervisors

Reporting to the Aquatics Co-ordinator, you will assist in the planning and evaluation of aquatics programs to ensure community aquatic recreational needs are met. Your involvement will also include training, scheduling, and supervising all part-time staff, maintaining financial records, and liaising with community groups, associations, the general public, and staff.
