Public told 'be patient' with town road crews

Some local roads are in poor condition because of last year's rain, and the town is asking for the public's "patience" during this spring's unpredictable weather.

Public works superintendent Denis Chartrand said "weather is the determining factor" in overall poor road conditions in many parts of Whitchurch-Stouffville.

Chartrand explained some roads are in such deplorable condition they may need to be shut down temporarily, and will be considered impassable by the town until repair work can be done.

He said "spring break-up" or surface heaving is caused when frost comes out of the ground quickly.

He said the "tremendous rainfall" from last year, coupled with overall wet conditions saturated road bases before they froze up for the winter.

"The last few days of warm weather has caused the frost to come out too quickly," and the cold spell which has followed will likely make conditions even worse, he said.

The poorest sections have been posted this week with 'Caution - Broken Road' signs warning motorists, and Chartrand advises drivers to take heed.

"If you see these signs - we mean what they say. If you don't have to travel on them, don't."

He said although the town will attempt to patch the worst areas as soon as possible, the majority of work will not be undertaken until the warmer weather.

"We have to wait until the water comes out of the ground - major road repairs will not be done until summer," Chartrand said.

The worst roads, which the town is monitoring daily, are Vandorf Sideroad between Hwy 48 and McCowan Road, and Bethesda Sideroad between the 9th Line and McCowan Road, he said.

"Plus there are a number of blemishes on many other roads" throughout the municipality, he said.

Chartrand said the department has little money left for road repairs, and must wait until officials finalize this year's budget before undertaking major repair jobs.

Chartrand said some of the roads are in such poor condition the public works department may have to "re-assess its priorities" and shelve projects slated to begin this year.

"Other road jobs may have to be re-assessed to deal with these problems," he said.

Chartrand said the town may need to look at a long-term construction program to deal with yearly patch work problems.

"It all comes down to economics," he said.
