As Chair of The York Region Board of Education I am shocked and deeply disappointed by the publication of a personal arrangement between the Director and The York Region Board of Education. The disregard for the privacy of Mr. Cressman who will be leaving the Board as Director on July 1, 1993, and who has served the Board so admirably for the past 12 years, is to be condemned.

The overwhelming majority of the Board supported the decisions regarding the way in which Mr. Cressman would step aside as Director of the Board. Last fall the Board decided that a new Director would be hired as of July 1, 1993. The recent decisions change only the nature of the services that Mr. Cressman will be providing to the Board next year. Because the decisions were essentially personal in nature, the decisions were made in private session. The Board respects the privacy of all of its employees and deeply regrets the disclosure of our most senior employee's personal arrangement with the Board as he ends his tenure as Director.

As Chair of the Board, I also regret that any of our trustees decided to comment publicly on a matter discussed in private session.

As Chair of the Board, I would like to publicly reaffirm my gratitude for the fine leadership that Mr. Cressman has given the Board over the last 12 years and my pleasure in the addendum to his employment contract which recognizes his contribution. I wish him well in his future endevours in private enterprise.


