York Region police to get tough on seatbelts

Last week York Regional Police offered motorists who disobeyed the buckle-up law a grace period. Between April 8 and 17, 699 warning tickets were handed to motorists for seat belt violations.

Motorists don't have to pay a fine for these warning tickets, but during a provincial enforcement campaign lasting until the end of April, officers will hand out genuine tickets for seat belt infractions.
