## PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

In May 1991, the Natural Features Study was inaugurated to identify and evaluate all remaining natural features in the Town and to develop a strategy to conserve, protect and enhance the natural environment. The study team was led by Gore and Storrie Ltd., specialists in environmental planning.

The Phase 1 Report - the inventory and evaluation of the natural features - was presented to the public last June. The consultants' recommendations on a comprehensive strategy (Phase 2 Report) were received by Council on March 30, 1993 and have been released for discussion.
