The purpose of the program is two-fold, according to a press release from the association this week.

Second, it will increase the awareness of the environment for the students of Summitview.

During the three-week campaign, students, staff and parents will be able to purchase a leaf for 50¢ each and have his/her name, plus a photo if they wish, on their leaf on the Summitview Family Tree which will be on display in the lobby of the school.

In return for a donation, each person will receive a tree seed kit provided by the Ontario Forestry Association, Trees Ontario.

Also, students will receive a Dr. Nature First Aider Certificate in recognition for their contribution to improving the environment.

On Wednesday, May 12, Dr. Nature (Kevin Callen) will inform and entertain students about the connection between the tree of Summitview and the ecology of Canada and the world.

After this presentation, the tree planting ceremony will take place. The tree has been supplied by Bouwmeister Landscaping, Ltd.

One tree will take care of 40 tons of pollution in its lifetime. Plant a tree for your children's future.
