AMENDMENT TO DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAW NO. DC 1-91-136

On May 27, 1993, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York will hold a public meeting pursuant to Section 4(1) of the Development Charges Act, 1989. The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of a proposed amendment to Regional Development Charges By-law No. DC 1-91-136.

The following is the proposed policy revision to the Regional Development Charges By-law:

Building permit applications for non-residential additions, which create additional non-residential gross floor area, be suspended from the payment of Regional Development charges on an interim basis effective the date of the amending by-law to November 23, 1994, inclusive.
