We wish to especially thank The Tribune, The Weekender, Bruce Stapley and staff for their great promotion.

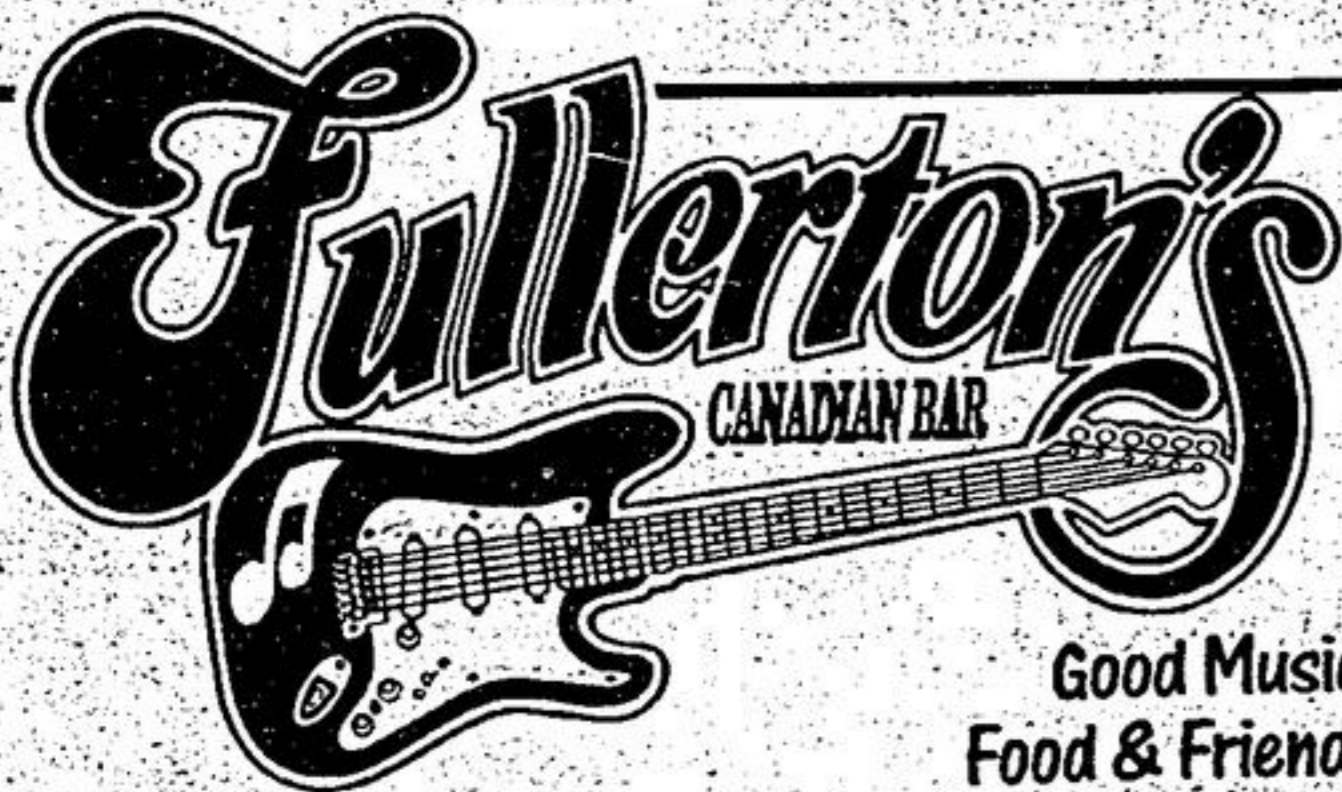
This kind of support by the media is a priceless asset to the show's continued success.

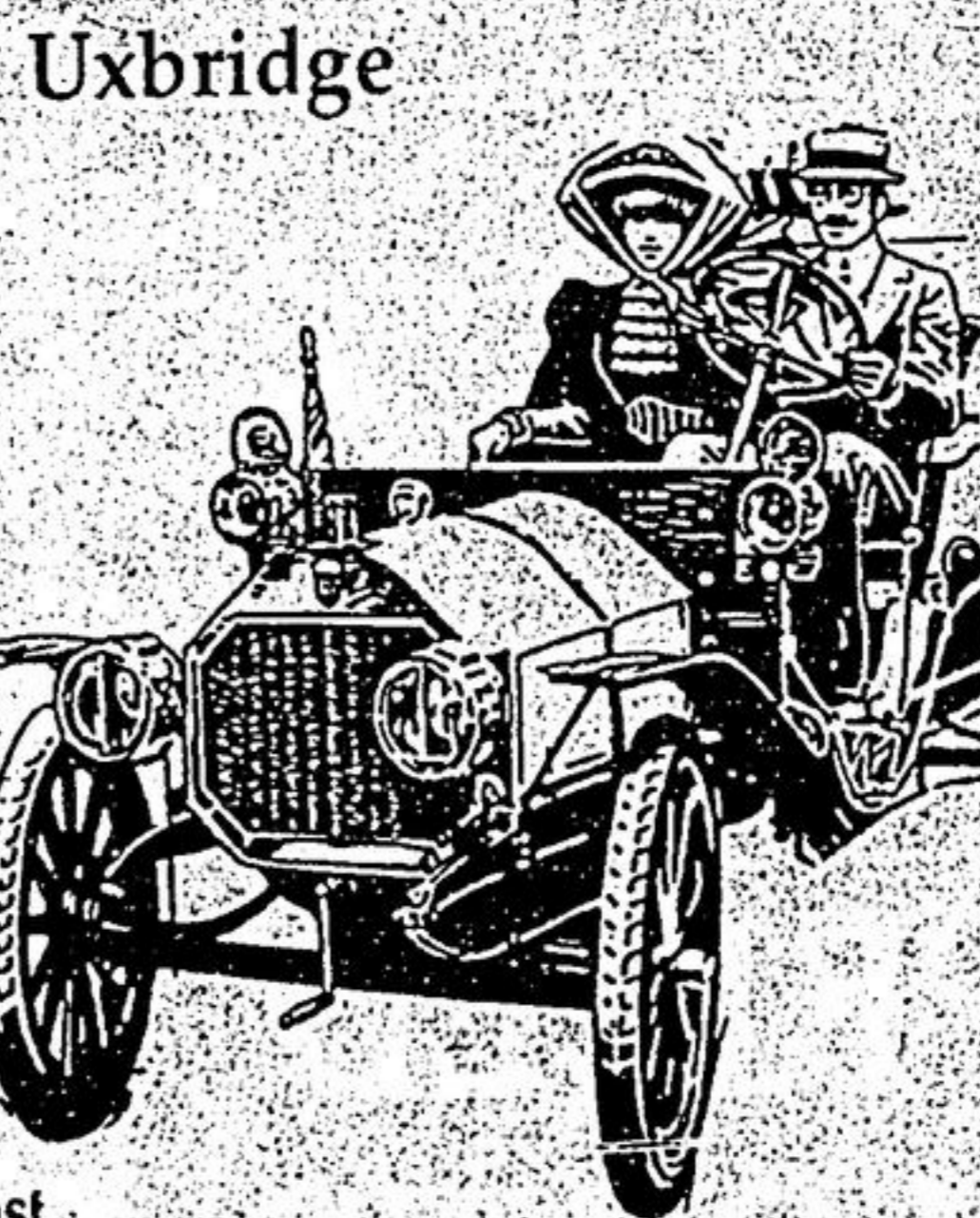
