

ST Spartan boys aim for softball title

The Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans boys' softball team was out to regain the York Region crown on Tuesday.

The Spartans, who advanced to the final with an 8-3 win over Vaughan S.S. in Thursday's semi-final match, were to play either Markham D.H.S. or Dr. G.W. Williams S.S. (Aurora) at the Newmarket Fairgrounds for the regional championship.

The Spartans used a five-run second inning to overcome Vaughan Thursday, with pitcher Jody Infurnari keying the rally with

a home run. Jason Reesor banded a triple in the big inning, while Ryan Burkholder and Jeff Taber each contributed doubles.

Infurnari recorded seven strikeouts in going the distance for the Spartans.

The Spartans, who had a perfect 6-0 record in the regular schedule, crushed Bradford H.S. 14-1 in their quarter-final match Tuesday. Infurnari coasted on the pitching rubber, with Stuart Pegg blasting a round tripper. Ian Ellis and Burkholder also led the Spartans offence.
