Compliments from the Tribune

The long winter evenings are drawing in, and a world to do how they may be spent to profit will be in order. In this age of business rush and haste to accumulate golden dollars many exercise their physical powers to their fullest capacity, leaving no time to store the mind with useful and financially profitable knowledge. In the case of young men who have left school and taken a situation in some of our shops no better employment could be engaged, in during spare evenings than to become a member of our Public Library (which costs only the trifling sum of \$1 a year), and make diligent use of both the reading room and collection in town. A village has given opportunities of storing the mind with useful knowledge, so we have a large and excellent collection of books and the reading room is supplied with the best magazines, periodicals and works of reference. Our minds cannot be stored up with too much useful information, and we know not but that in after life it may become of very much benefit. Besides the pursuit of knowledge to those who have come interested in the matter of great satisfaction. Recreation for the young is all very well in its place, but in youth is the time to develop the mental faculties and fill the treasure-house of knowledge which cannot be done more conveniently and satisfactorily than by taking advantage of the Public Library.

From reports coming from all parts of Ontario typhoid fever appears to be more prevalent than in former years, and it is a disease which requires a good constitution to withstand its ravages. The bacteria to which it owes its origin seem to subsist on decaying animal matter, hence the necessity of cleanliness in regard to outhouses and premises generally. The cellar is often a fruitful source of contagion, especially as regards diphtheria and typhoid fever, and its contents should be carefully kept free from decomposition as far as possible. Next comes the domestic water supply. It is not generally known that deleterious matter may filter as far as two hundred feet and contaminate our wells. Where wells exist on small lots there is great danger that the infiltration from the back yards and closets may render the water totally unfit to use. The bacteria are destroyed by heating the water to the boiling point but how many would go to the trouble of boiling water for drinking purposes? It seems to us that it will not be many years till Stouffville will find that from a sanitary point of view a system of water works will be a profitable investment. It is true that there are many good wells in town, but it is also true that it is an old village with, in many places, the accumulations of about half a century in the back yards and no doubt in the densely inhabited portions the ground is saturated with death-dealing filth which will eventually tell on the health of the community. All that can be done under the present circumstances is to exercise the greatest precautions in regard to the removal and disposal of all refuse and sanitary matter. Cleanliness is next to godliness; the latter produces a sense of spirit, while the former is conducive to health of body.
