

Grimshaw sentencing put off once again

Ed Grimshaw's sentencing has been delayed yet again. The former local Whitchurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association official convicted earlier this year on three counts of theft and fraud involving funds belonging to that body has had his sentencing delayed for a third time. Mr. Justice John McIsaac was to have handed down Grimshaw's sentence last Monday at the Newmarket

court house. But Grimshaw produced a letter from a doctor requesting time be allowed for tests pertaining to Grimshaw's heart. Grimshaw is seeking a second opinion regarding possible surgery, according to the crown attorney's office. The crown said McIsaac is determined to hand down sentencing Aug. 26 at 9:30 a.m.
