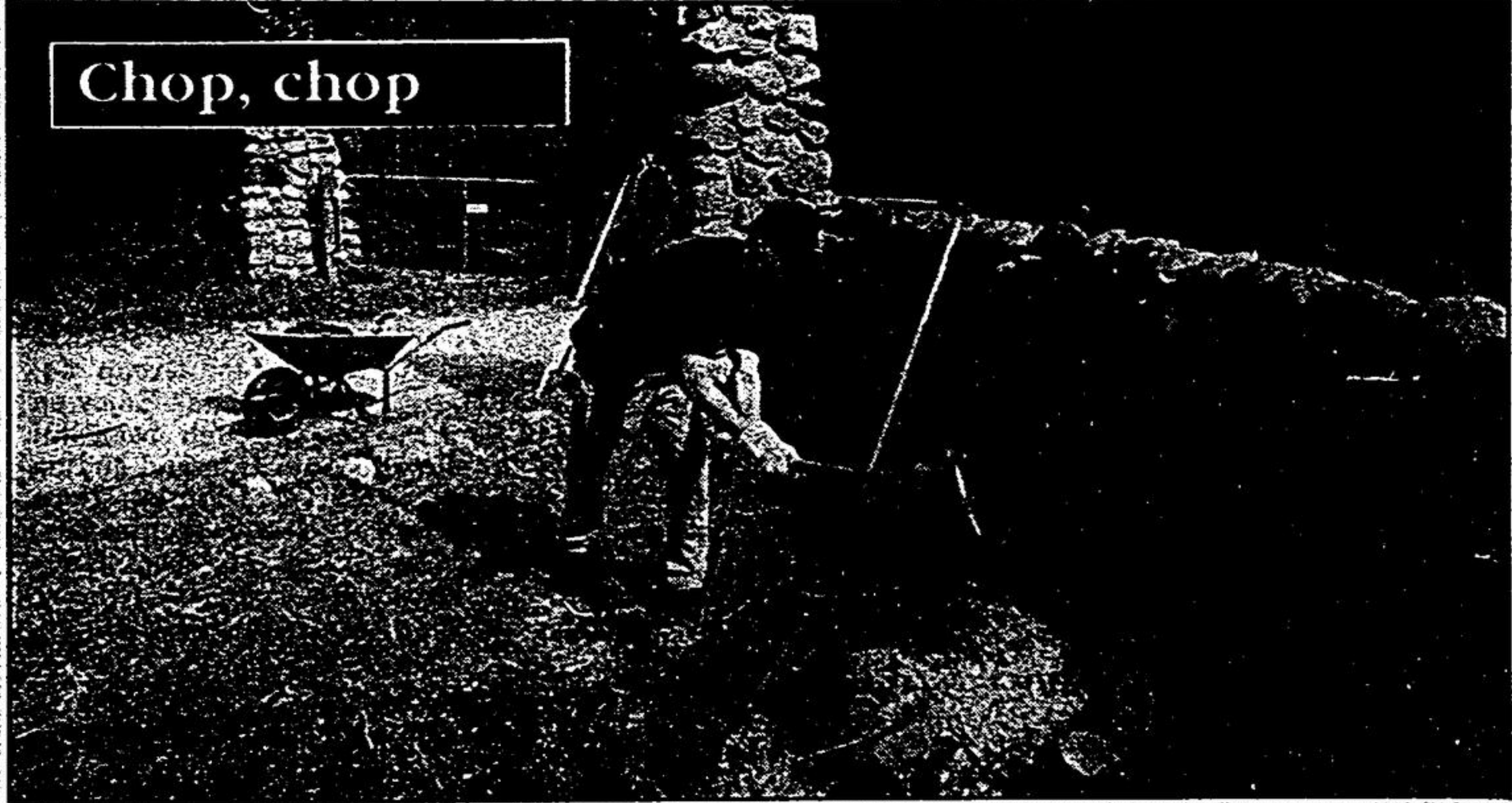

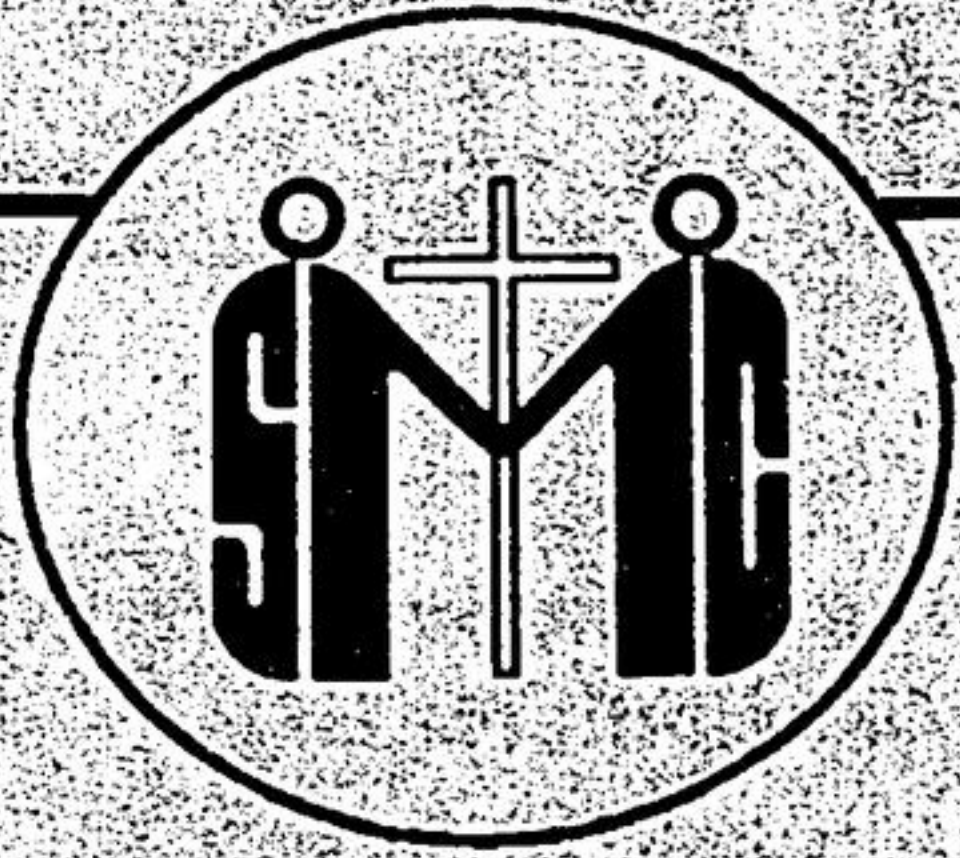

**1994 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS NOTICE
PROXY VOTING**

Those persons that are qualified to vote in this year's municipal elections on November 14th, 1994, but will be absent from the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, are advised that you may arrange to have someone vote on your behalf via Proxy Voting Certificates. Pursuant to the Municipal Elections Act:

- (a) Any person whose name is entered in the voters list or who has obtained a certificate from the Clerk may vote by proxy.
- (b) Any person who will be unable to vote on election day may appoint in writing on the prescribed form any other person who is eligible as an elector in the municipality to vote on their behalf.
- (c) A Voting Proxy may not act as a voting proxy for more than one person, except where voting on behalf of an immediate relative. (Section 73(3) of the Municipal Elections Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.53)

Applications for Proxy Voting Certificates may be made at the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Clerk's Office, 19 Civic Avenue, Stouffville, during regular office hours 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Applications may be submitted at any time between October 17th 1994 and November 14th, 1994.
