**QUALIFICATIONS OF AN ELECTOR**

To be eligible to vote, and elector must qualify under the following criteria at any time  
between September 6th to October 14th, 1994 (the Revision Period):

- be a resident in the municipality; or
- be the owner or tenant of land in the municipality or the spouse of such owner or  
tenant;
- be a Canadian Citizen; and
- be eighteen years of age or will be eighteen years of age on or before Voting Day.

Persons that were not eligible to be entered on the Preliminary Voters List during the  
Revision Period, but who have since become a Canadian Citizen, may apply to the  
Clerk for a certificate to vote on Voting Day.

**TO ELECTORS**

Electors are urged to vote early to avoid possible congestion at the polls.

**OFFENCES, PENALTIES AND ENFORCEMENT**

Every person who, at an election,

- not being qualified to vote, votes;
  - being qualified to vote, votes more times than he is authorized to vote by this Act; or
  - votes in a polling subdivision other than one in which he is entitled to vote by this Act,  
is guilty of a corrupt practice and is liable to a fine of up to \$5,000 an/or imprisonment.

**1994 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS NOTICE**

**VOTING CERTIFICATES**

Qualified electors whose names were omitted from the Preliminary Voters List and  
who did not request an amendment to the list during the Revision Period (September  
6th, 1994 to October 14th, 1994), may now, apply to the Clerk's Office, in person, at  
19 Civic Avenue, Stouffville, to obtain a Clerk's Certificate which will entitle them to  
vote. Clerk's Certificates may be obtained:

Monday to Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

From October 17th, 1994 to November 14th, 1994

A person is entitled to be an elector if at any time during the period commencing on  
September 6th, 1994 and ending on October 14th, 1994, he or she is:

- a resident in the municipality;
- a Canadian citizen; and
- of the age of eighteen years, or will attain the age of eighteen years on or  
before polling day.

- OR -

**IF NOT A RESIDENT IN THE MUNICIPALITY**

- is the Owner or tenant of land in the municipality or is the spouse of such  
owner or tenant;
- a Canadian citizen; and
- of the age of eighteen years, or will attain the age of eighteen years on or  
before polling day.

Alternatively if you are a qualified elector and your name has been omitted from the  
Voter's List but you are unable to attend at the Clerk's Office to obtain a Clerk's  
Certificate, you will be permitted to vote provided that you satisfactorily identify  
yourself to the Deputy Returning Officer and take a Declaration on the prescribed  
form before the Deputy Returning Officer at the voting location in which you qualify to  
vote. Make sure that you bring proper identification with you which includes your  
qualifying address.

If you have become a Canadian Citizen since October 14th, 1994, and have the  
above qualifications, you may also PERSONALLY obtain a certificate to Vote from the  
Town Clerk if you provide proof of citizenships.
