Ontario, these three Scrolls are each 8 feet high, over 100 yards long and

of the Holy Land. Because of their frail condition, they are very rarely  
displayed.  
Videotapes about Masonry will also be shown. The Lodge Room will be  
open, and local Masons will be present to explain the significance of the  
many symbols contained therein.
