Stouffville Lions Club makes holiday happier for needy

The Stouffville Lions Club has worked to make Christmas happier for needy area families since 1938 and this year will be no exception.

Donations of new or almost new toys, books, games and other items suitable to be given as gifts are

requested from individuals, organizations and businesses in the community. While presents for young children are always welcome, said Lions' chairman Tom Winters, there is also a need for donations for older children and teenagers.

He suggested that families

with teens of their own discuss gift ideas with their children and make them feel part of the spirit of giving. Items for teens could include certificates for CDs, tapes or books, plaid shirts, boxer shorts or movie passes.

Financial contributions, which are used to purchase food and gifts, are also welcomed by the club. Involving all family members in helping others makes Christmas very special for everyone, Winters noted.

In some cases, he said, people adopt a specific fam-

ily through the club. "If people are interested in sponsoring a family they should get in touch with us."

Although all recipients are guaranteed anonymity, sponsors will be supplied with the ages of the children and any special gift requests. If anyone knows of a family who they feel is in need of support, they can contact a club member.

The drive gets under way Dec. 1 and the Stouffville Country Flea Market will be donating turkeys again this year, said Winters. "It's

amazing the amount of help we get, it's a case of total community involvement."

Without that support and the help of the media in getting the word out, he stressed, the Christmas project would not be possible.

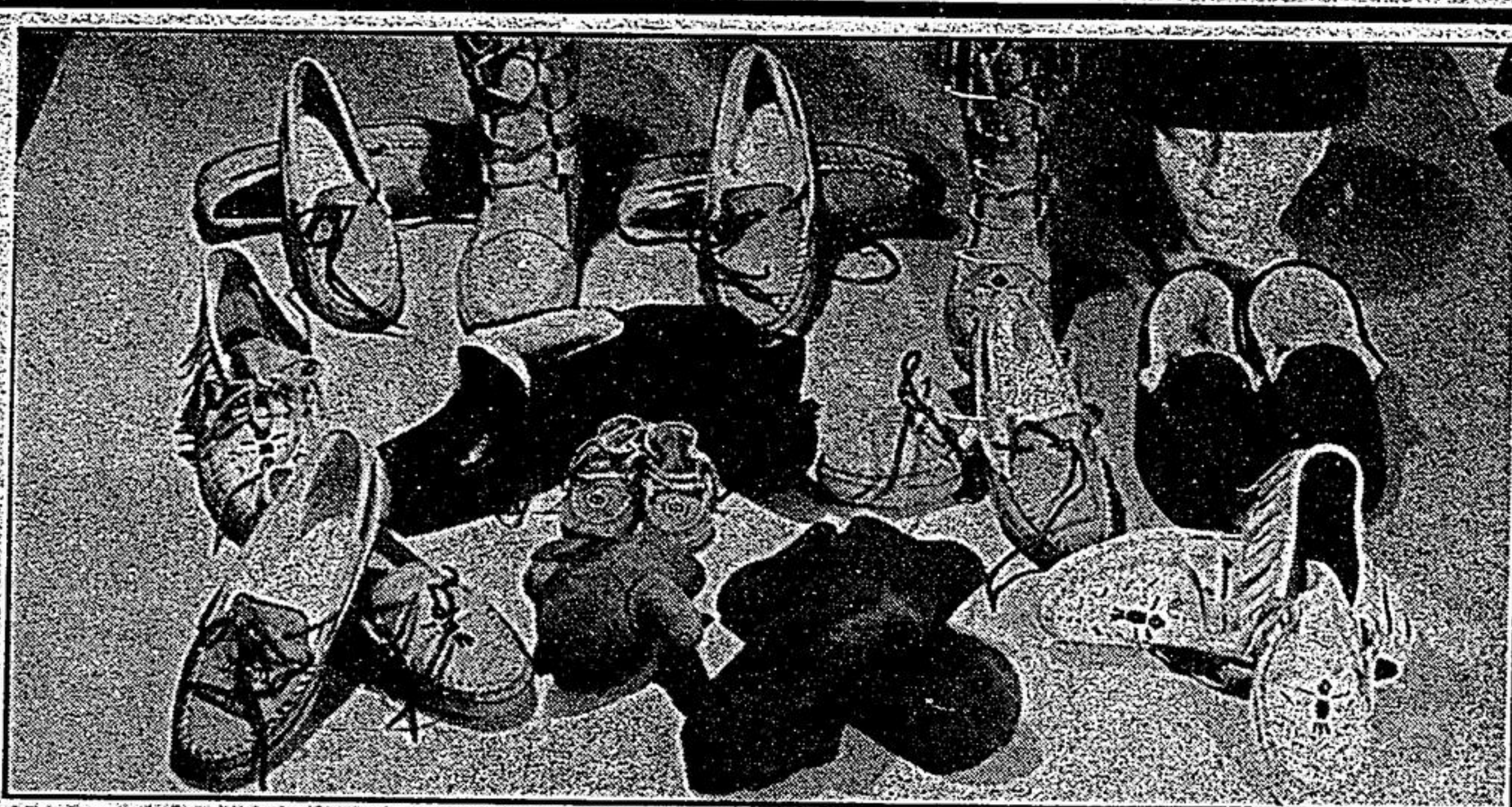
