Fun for the kids - Craft puffy mouse, teddy and reindeer

The following craft instructions are taken from the White Rose Crafts & Nursery Ltd., *The Biggest Ornament Book Ever*, which contains over 120 projects.

PUFFY MOUSE MATERIALS:

- 1/4 square each grey and white felt
- piece of dark pink felt
- 1/2 m (20") double sided red/green ribbon - 6mm (1/4") wide
- 3" black stamens
- 1 black pom pon - 6mm (1/4")
- 2 paste-on eyes - 7mm
- fine black fabric marker
- 1/4 grey chenille stem
- polyester fibrefill

TEDDY MATERIALS:

- 1/3 square dark brown felt
- pieces of beige, red, light pink felt
- 2 paste-on eyes - 7mm
- 15cm (6") double sided red/green ribbon - 6mm (1/4") wide
- 1 white pom pon - 13mm (1/2")
- fine black fabric marker
- polyester fibrefill

REINDEER MATERIALS:

- 1/3 square dark brown felt
- pieces of beige, red, white and pink felt
- 1 red pom pon - 13mm (1/2")
- 2 paste-on eyes - 7mm
- 15cm (6") double sided red/green ribbon - 6mm (1/4") wide
- polyester fibrefill

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut felt shapes following the patterns given (see pattern insert, SIDE B).
2. Glue together and stuff the main body shapes and the mouse's gift. The ear sections are not stuffed in the reindeer or mouse.
3. **TEDDY AND REINDEER:** Glue a 6 mm (1/4") strip of white felt around the bottom to form a brim. Fold down and glue the tip to one side. Glue the white pom pon to the tip as in Diagrams B and C.
4. Glue the remaining felt pieces, eyes, pom pons, stamens, chenille stems and ribbon in place as in Diagrams A, B and C.
