The 1995 Whitchurch-Stouffville Dog Tags are available in the Municipal Offices at 19 Civic Avenue, Stouffville. The Annual Licence fee payable BY FEBRUARY 28, 1995 is \$15.00 for the first dog and \$30.00 for each additional dog. As of MARCH 1, 1995 the cost for the first dog will be \$20.00.

(Senior Citizens 50% of the above rate, no charge for guide dogs owned by the blind).

Proof of vaccination against rabies must be shown when purchasing a dog tag, otherwise all tags are \$50.00.

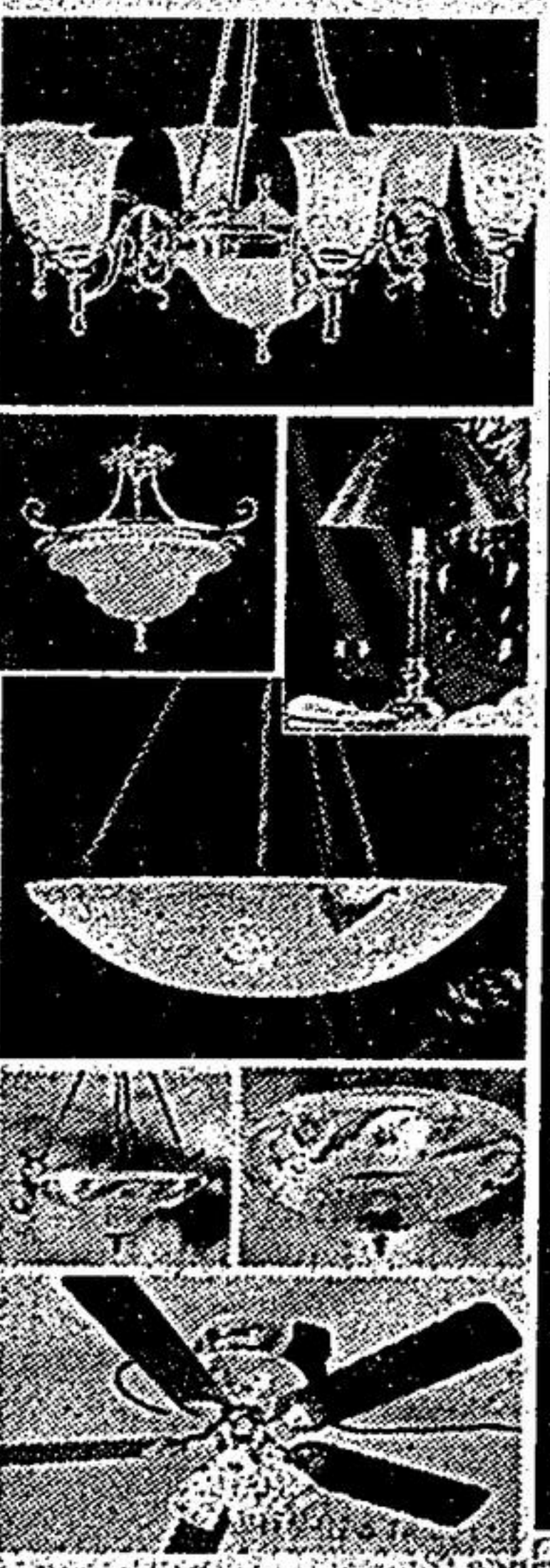

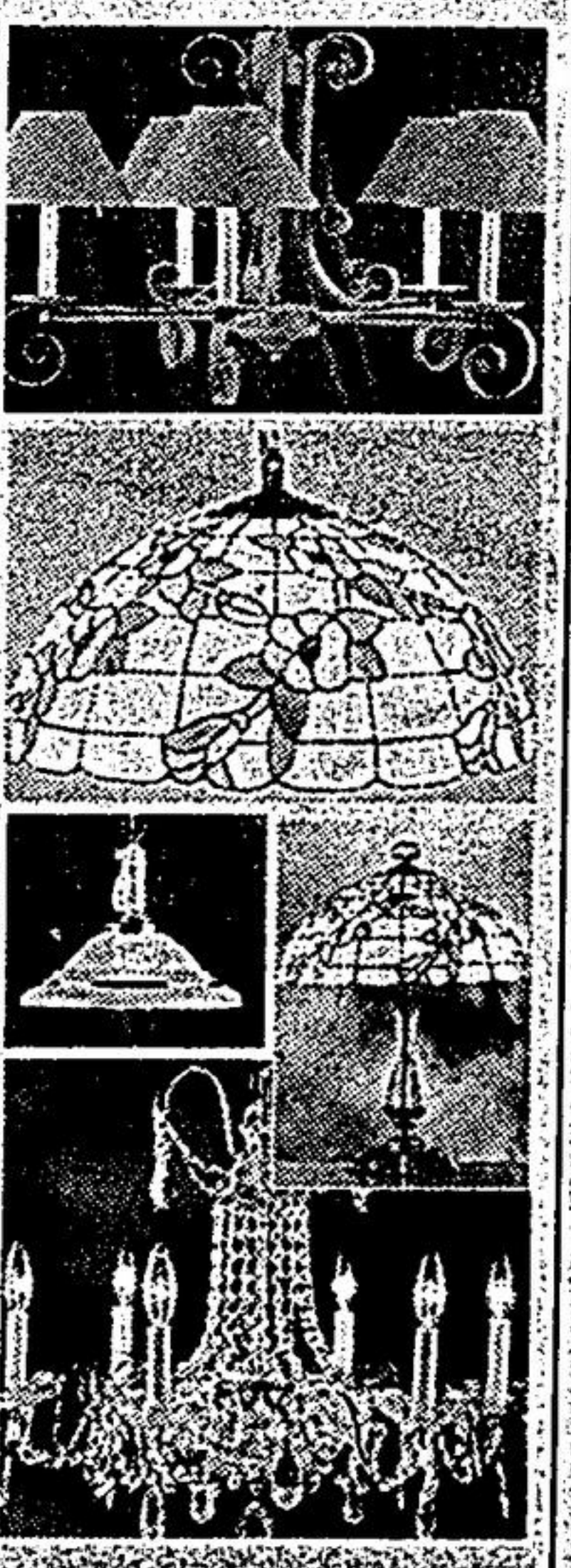

Use It or Lose It

Are you aware that 1994 was the last year in which you were able to take advantage of Revenue Canada's \$100,000 capital gains tax exemption?

If you can answer "yes" to any of the following questions you could be eligible for all or part of the exemption:

- do you own a cottage
- do you own rental property
- do you own a small business
- do you have an investment portfolio
- do you own collectibles such as art, stamp collection, coin collection, antiques etc.

If you answered "yes" to any of the above questions you may need professional advice on whether or not you qualify.

If you qualify, Revenue Canada has made provision for recognizing the increased value of your possessions and at the same time allowing you to retain ownership.

At first glance it looks to be simple and straightforward. You make a capital gains election report on your 1994 personal tax return which will be offset by up to \$100,000 of personal gains exemption.

However there are conditions. The election must be filed along with your tax return and cannot be filed later than April 30, 1995. There will be no extension and no appeal.

Like all financial dealings with Revenue Canada there are

severe penalties for making an inaccurate election or exemption claim and Revenue Canada must be contacted to confirm certain details of your tax history prior to filing for an exemption.

The procedure presents little or no problem for anyone who is experienced in working with Revenue Canada and knows the exemption terms.

The two month turnaround period for getting the necessary information back from Ottawa is probably the greatest barrier to making a successful application because time is running out and April 30th looms closer with every passing day.

For many who want to take advantage of the exemption and haven't done so the best advice one could give, at this late date, is let an expert help you meet the deadline and avoid the possible pitfalls.
