

Minor novices claim title in Woodville Tournament

The Birkett and Hassard minor novice Clippers were champions at the Woodville Tri-County Novice Tournament over the weekend, winning all three games played.

The Clippers were led on offence by Justin Hitchen and Michael Lombardo with three goals each, with Cale Tanaka and Jonathan Wonch picking up two goals apiece.

Single scores came from Joshua Spang and Bobby Hughes.

The Clippers kicked off the tourney with a 4-2 win over Haliburton as Justin Lyons was named MVP.

A 5-2 victory over Bradford sent the Clippers to the finals, where they claimed the title with a 4-1 triumph over the host squad.

Spang and Lombardo were named MVPs in the second and third games respectively.

Assists in the three games went to Spang (5), Hitchen (2), Tanaka (2), Wonch, Devon McDougall, Hughes and Lombardo (one each). Lyons, Ryan Thom and Richard Little also contributed to the championship effort, while goalkeeper Shawn Gibson was solid in all three games.

Bruins, Chiefs to face off in playoffs

The Uxbridge Bruins go into the first round of the Central Ontario Junior C Hockey League playoffs against the Lakefield Chiefs this week with something to prove.

The Bruins, who were to open the best-of-seven set with a game at the Uxbridge Arena on Tuesday, ended up fourth behind the Port Perry Mojacks and the Georgina Ice respectively in the tight three-way battle for second place.

The Bruins missed a chance to take third when they were downed 8-5 by the runaway league leading Bowmanville Eagles Friday in Uxbridge. The Bruins failed to take one

point from the Eagles in six games between the two teams this season.

Bruins general manager Bruce Colwell said the fourth-place showing is less than indicative of his team's true standing in the league.

"I think we'll be there with Bowmanville in the league finals, and I predict it will be a good six or seven game series," said Colwell.

Against the Eagles Friday, it was a case of the Bruins shedding their early jitters as they fell behind 3-0 after the first period.

Second-period goals by Mike Norris, Brandon Pridham and Matt Muir brought the Bruins even, but the Eagles caught a break to regain the lead before the period was out.

Bowmanville then scored four times compared to the Bruins' two in the third. Stu Vandergeest and Jermain Franklin had the other Uxbridge goals.

Jeff Bain collected a pair of assists for the Bruins.

"We gave them a real good game," said Colwell. "But the players had the jitters at the start and they (Bowmanville) put in three quick goals. We tied them after that."

Game two of the Bruins set with Lakefield goes Friday at 8:30 p.m. in Uxbridge, with games three and four to go Saturday and Sunday in Lakefield.

Games five and seven, if necessary, will be played next Tuesday and Friday nights in Uxbridge, with game six to go next Wednesday in Lakefield.
