Minor atom Clippers ice title

Two guys named Lukas were the heroes as the SVB minor atom Clippers were champions and the Aiken's DA minor pee wee Clippers went to the finals in the Whitchurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association Pee-wee Atom Tournament at the Rec Centre over the weekend.

Minor atom Clippers, goalkeeper Lukas Hunter, was named game MVP as he backstopped his team to a 6-3 win over Innisfil in Sunday's title contest. The Clippers went undefeated in four games on their way to the crown.

Lukas Williams collected 12 of his team's 20 goals as the minor pee wee Clippers were finally stopped 7-2 by London in Sunday's championship match up. Williams had five goals in the Clippers opening game 9-1 win over East Gwillimbury. He added another marker in a 3-3 tie with Ancaster in game two, then broke loose for

four more as the Clippers downed Niagara Falls 6-2 in game three. He had both Stouffville scores in the final against London.

The minor atom Clippers started out with an 8-3 triumph over Markham, then hung defeats of 11-0 and 3-1 on East Gwillimbury and Owen Sound respectively their next two times out. MVP honors in the three games went to Blair Loughead, Jordan Mabley and Scott Davis.

Rod Assinck had four goals and six assists to lead the minor atom Clippers, scorers in the tournament. Mabley had six goals and an assist, Shawn Burns, Mike Sullivan and Josh Brillinger each had four goals and an assist, Brian Montgomery three goals and an assist, Mike Cornacchia one goal and two assists, Blair Loughead five assists, Jesse Miller three assists, Cameron O'Neill, Brad Peterson and Mathew Wright two assists apiece and Andy Gibson one assist.

Other minor pee wee goals came from Ryan Zonnekeyn and Ryan Fontanna (3), Peter Smith (3), David Brown, Williams, Brent Meyer, Cain and Justin Heyworth.

Clippers MVPs for the four games were Zonnekeyn, Nick Straughan, Williams and Meyer.

The pee wee Clippers advanced to the second round of the OMHA playoffs with a 5-2 win over Uxbridge in recent action.

The minor atom Clippers tied Uxbridge 2-2 in a play-off game last Tuesday, with Brillinger and Burns scoring. Sullivan had an assist.
