

# Golf tourney will raise funds for Mobility Transit

After a year in operation, Whitchurch-Stouffville Mobility Transit has proved a vital resource for physically handicapped area residents.

To ensure its continued success, financial support from individuals and businesses in the community is essential. A group of sponsors gathered at the Earl of Whitchurch Wednesday evening to announce a major fundraiser to aid the service.

Tuesday, May 30, 1995 has been set as the date for a new high profile golf tournament in support of

Whitchurch-Stouffville Mobility Transit, volunteer Wayne Feasby told the large crowd which packed the upstairs dining room at the pub.

"The tournament will be billed as the Digital Processing Systems first annual, in honor of our lead corporate sponsor."

Stouffville resident John Fazackerley is the Scarborough company's chairman and chief executive officer. His wife presented Feasby with a cheque for \$4,000 on his behalf.

"We are really pleased with the initial response," said Feasby.

"Already we have several sponsors committed, such as

Farmer Jack's, Algonquin Brewing Company, Appleton Rum, Castlevan Insurance, Schell Lumber, Tokai of Canada and Williamson Motors."

"This is an example of the members of our community working together to solve a problem on their own," said Mayor Wayne Emmerson. "I applaud the organizers, cor-

porate sponsors and of course those planning to golf for this most worthwhile and needed service."

MPP Larry O'Connor, a strong supporter of Mobility Transit, also praised the fundraising initiative.

Following the cheque presentation, everyone was invited to hone their putting skills in a friendly contest.

Whitchurch-Stouffville Mobility Transit is a non-profit organization which provides 24-hour, seven-day-a-week service for people with physical disabilities who have no other means of transport.

On average, 250 people used the service every month in 1994 for a variety of purposes including social,

shopping and medical trips, and the need for Mobility Transit is constantly growing.

The group's annual meeting takes place Feb. 28 and everyone in the community is welcome to attend.

working lives, and at the same time get the prescription drugs they need," said the local MPP.

In launching the plan, Grier emphasized that the new drug program isn't intended to take the place of drug insurance that people have privately or through their work.

O'Connor pointed out, however, that there are many people who do not have drug insurance or who have exhausted their benefits because they need very expensive drugs.

Beginning April 1, people with high drug expenses should start saving their receipts. "Once they have paid a specified portion of their taxable family income for their drugs, they become eligible to apply for the program," explained O'Connor.

Once people are approved for the program, they can use their health cards at their pharmacy for the rest of the fiscal year or receive, without costs, prescription drugs approved by the Ontario Drug Benefit plan.

Brochures further explaining the Trillium Drug program will be available in local pharmacies very soon.
