Meeda Harding remembered as an independent senior

The friends and family of Meeda Harding gathered at the O'Neill Funeral Home Monday afternoon to say goodbye to an independent senior of many involvements.
 Mrs. Harding died last Friday evening on the eve of her 91st birthday.
 The Ninth Line N. Stouffville resident, who lived on her own until taking ill recently, had remained active throughout her entire life.
 She was secretary treasurer of the Stouffville Women's Institute from 1967 until the time of her death and was active with the Stouffville Legion's Ladies Auxiliary until 1989. She belonged to the Stouffville Friendship Club and was a member of the Ballantrae Seniors group.

Mrs. Harding, who drove a car until she was 88, belonged to the Bloomington Christian Gospel Church. She was the head of that church's women's quilting group.
 Until her eyesight failed in recent years, Mrs. Harding was involved in a wide variety of crafts and took a course in chair caning five years ago. Mrs. Harding was born and raised at Bloomington near Stouffville. She resided as a child in the house which became the original Green Gables Manor retirement home on Ninth Line N. The house was built by her grandfather Maxon Jones, a former reeve of Whitechurch and the man who gave Bloomington its name.
 She attended Bloomington Public School and later, the Stouffville Con-

tinuation School on Main St. E. She worked in the Dr. Freer medical office on Main St. until marrying the late Oliver Harding in 1931.
 The Hardings lived in Toronto for a short time, then returned in 1936. Mrs. Harding's Stouffville heritage can be traced back to when her great-grandfather, Norman Jones, came to this area from Pennsylvania in 1821.
 Mrs. Harding was the only child of the late John and Ida Cleaver. She leaves behind her four children, Jess Ayers, Arthur, Isobel, Dunn and Oliver (Buster). She also leaves 10 grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.
 There is to be a spring interment at the Stouffville Cemetery.
