Grizzly Dance author Ann Love visits library March 29

Author Ann Love, who made her debut as a novelist last year, will visit Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library on Wednesday, March 29 at 7:30 p.m.

She will read from her book Grizzly Dance and discuss the mechanics and problems involved in writing a first novel and having it published.

Grizzly Dance, one of the initial novels published by Key Porter Books since it launched this category, is a taut murder mystery set in the Yukon.

The author has first-hand experience of the locale in her book. She and her husband lived there for four years in the '70s when they were founders and teachers at the Carcross Community Education Centre, an alternative high school.

Ann is the author of three books for chil-

dren, including the 1993 bestseller, The Kid's Cottage Book. She graduated in honors English from Trinity College and during her years at University of Toronto, was founder of Pollution Probe, an environmental advocacy group, and editor of its newsletters. It's no surprise then that Grizzly Dance has a strong environmental theme and that its protagonist, RCMP officer Warren Tasker, pursues his intricate investigation against the backdrop of the northern wilderness.

"Ann Love has created a well written and researched topical novel...she gets an A for her depictions of complex contemporary lives and what happens when citizens and legislators clash over environmental issues," writes book reviewer Robert Durrell. "I look forward to reading her next novel as she appears an able writer with a lot of important

ideas to put forward." On March 29, the author will put forward her ideas

and her book for a stimulating literary presentation that's sure to be of

interest to mystery lovers and anyone hopeful of writing a first novel.
