# Major and minor novice Clippers ice tourney titles

The host teams ran off with the hardware at the Whitchurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association Novice Tournament, held at the Rec Centre during the March break. Mark Carruthers scored with 10 seconds remaining in the game to give the Ken and Neil Patrick major novice Clippers a 3-2 win over Port Perry in their championship final.

The Birkett and Hassard minor novice Clippers rebounded from a 4-3 loss to Markham in their opener to take their next three games, including a 3-0 win over Bradford in their championship tilt.

The Ken and Neil Patrick major novices bounced Cookville 5-2 in their first game and followed that with a 6-1 win over the Toronto East Enders and a 6-0 shutout over the Scarborough Sabres.

The Clippers received solid netminding from Mike McManus and Trevor McNeely throughout the tournament. Alison Edward fired the other Stouffville goal, with assists going to Johnston and Kari Sandiford. The win qualified the Angie's squad for a spot in the provincial championships, which will be held in early April.
