Ice pad committee to launch 'no-frills' appeal

A pitch for a 'no-frills' 22,648-square-foot second ice pad is expected to be made to Whitchurch-Stouffville Council tonight.

The 45-minute appeal to council is being made by members of the steering committee for the second ice pad.

The plan calls for the ice pad, complete with two dressing rooms, to be built adjacent to the existing ice pad at the town's recreation centre on Recreation Lane. The cost of a second ice pad has been estimated at \$677,500. Council will be told that a major fundraising drive would help offset the cost.

"In the economic reality of today,

it is unrealistic for a community to expect our leaders to grant us our every whim for free. We as a collective group of users want a second ice pad and are willing to continue our efforts to achieve our goal," the committee members said.

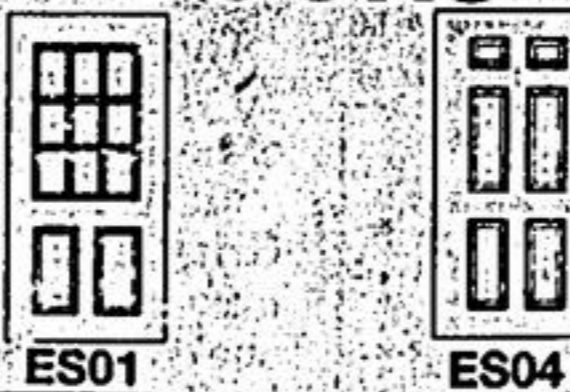
