Thieves have been busy in Stouffville area

Rings, bikes gone
Burglars entered an Aurora Road home Tuesday morning through some rear sliding doors.

The doors were opened at about 8 a.m., police believe. Two rings and bicycle were stolen. The property is valued at approximately \$1,300.

Stereo pilfered
Car stereo equipment was

stolen after thieves gained access to a Bayberry Street house through some unlocked doors.

The culprits accessed the garage through a side door and entered a car.

They removed an Alpine equalizer and AM/FM compact disc player from the vehicle.

The property is worth about \$1,300.

According to reports, about \$200 damage was also caused during the theft.

Police investigate fire
Fire crews were called Sunday to extinguish what authorities believe was a deliberately-set car fire.

According to reports, at approximately 5 a.m. the car was abandoned and set on fire near Ironwood Crescent and

Millard Street.

Damage has been estimated at \$15,000.

Window provides entry
An unlocked window provided burglars with access to a Main Street home Saturday afternoon.

According to police, the house was entered at about 6 p.m. Approximately \$300 cash was taken, reports indicated.

Tools stolen

Tools and gardening equipment were among thousands of dollars in property stolen from Magna International.

Last Thursday night, the company's garage in the Simeon industrial park just off of Woodbine Avenue was entered around 8 p.m. Police believe bolt cutters were used to cut through a chain securing the front gate.

Once inside, the culprits removed a window screen before gaining access to the main building.

A riding mower, generator, chain saw, drill press as well as various other garden and hand tools were among the estimated \$20,000 in stolen property the thieves removed from the garage.
