

# Christ Church Anglican hosts Caribbean Evening on Saturday

This Saturday, the auditorium in the new building at the Stouffville Country Market will be transformed into an island in the sun for the second annual Caribbean Evening in Stouffville, sponsored by Christ Church Anglican.

The winner will receive 50 per cent of the proceeds, with the remainder going to leukemia research. Among those taking part in Sunday's event are Mayor Wayne Emmeron and councillors Judy Scala and Cliff Dunkeld.

Registration starts at 10 a.m. and the walk begins at 11 a.m. Participants who wish can roller

blade, skateboard, bike or ride a wheelchair around the course and hot dogs and drinks will be served at the conclusion of the event.
