Privacy, personable and professional service are focus at Neece Electrolysis & Esthetics

Angela is a certified specialist in the procedure and has been practising in her Unionville clinic for over three years. Needles used are dispos-

able, she stresses.

Furthermore, the process is safe and discomfort is minimal. Appointments can be booked in 15-minute sessions and typically they are first made on a weekly basis with the frequency declining as the condition improves.

The comfortable setting at Neece Electrolysis also contributes to making the procedure a positive one. Pastel shades and floral prints enhance the immaculate clinic.
