THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

The Council of the Regional Municipality of York proposes to pass a by-law authorizing:

1. RECONSTRUCTION OF YORK/DURHAM LINE (YR 30) FROM STEELES AVENUE TO HIGHWAY 7, TOWN OF MARKHAM

- (a) the reconstruction of York/Durham Line (YR 30) from Steeles Avenue to approximately 25 metres south of Highway 7 to a basic width of 36 metres with additional widenings at cuts, fills and intersections to provide for one (1) lane in each direction plus left and right turn lanes at intersections;
- (b) the provision of illumination at all the intersections with York/Durham Line (YR 30);
- (c) the carrying out of all related works and undertakings in connection with the above; and
- (d) the acquisition of the necessary lands and interests in lands for the works described above.

Pursuant to Section 300 of the Municipal Act, the Transportation and Environmental Services Committee of the Regional Council will, at its meeting to be held at 11:00 a.m. on the 27th day of June, 1995 in Council Chambers at the City of Vaughan located at 2141 Major Mackenzie Drive, Maple, hear any person who claims that his/her lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard. Anyone wishing to be heard is requested to advise the Office of the Regional Clerk (Telephone 895-1231 or 731-0201, Extension 1303). If any party entitled to be heard does not attend at the hearing, the Committee may proceed in his/her absence and he/she will not be entitled to any further notice in the proceedings.

The proposed by-law and plans showing the proposed works may be inspected at the office of Brian Harrison, Director, Planning and Design Branch, at the Transportation Department located at the Regional Administrative Building at 17250 Yonge Street, Newmarket (Telephone 895-1200 or 764-6345).
