Buttermakers tourney is set

The 16th annual Williamson Buttermakers Slo-Pitch Tournament is the big draw as this year's Strawberry Festival offers a full lineup of athletic events.

The 40-team competition gets under way Friday evening and runs through Sunday, with the championship games scheduled.

The tournament will be broken into four divisions. Eight teams are to contest the \$600 Men's C division, with 12 squads chasing after the \$500 top prize in the Men's D flight.

The Men's Recreational loop will include 16 crews, with \$300 at stake for first place.

The rec division is to include a team made up of Stouffville area junior hockey players such as Jason Reesor of the Niagara Falls Thunder and Ryan Jefferson of the Uxbridge Bruins.

The mixed division, with eight teams, is offering \$400 for first place.

Also on tap for the festival is a lawn bowling tournament to be hosted by the Stouffville Lawn Bowling Club on Thursday from 1.30 to 8 p.m.

The Silver Jubilee Club is to hold a euchre tournament Friday from 2 to 4 p.m.

Canada Day's slate of activities kicks off with the annual Strawberry Festival Triathlon, which gets under way with a splash into Shadow Lake at 8 a.m.

A beach volleyball tournament is to go from 8.30 a.m. to 8 p.m. at the volleyball pit next to the Rec Centre.

There is also a basketball shootout at the Rec Centre at 11 a.m.

The Strawberry 10K run takes place on Sunday at 9 a.m. at the SDSS track.

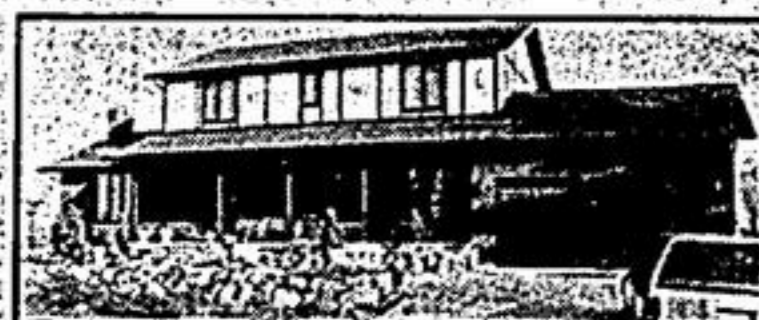
