Stouffville Junior A hockey team to host Russian Red Army squad

The Stouffville Spirit are still eight weeks from taking to the ice for their inaugural Provincial Junior A Hockey League game, but they've already got a main event lined up.

The Spirit will play host to the Russian Red Army team Dec. 23. The touring Red Army squad played in front of sold-out audiences during the 1994-95 season, according to Spirit officials.

Spirit general manager George Stavro said the team is taking shape as officials recruit players from as far away as Europe.

He said the team used two Toronto tournaments in May and June as mini-tryout camps for many players.

"We are committed to having a

winning team right away in Stouffville in addition to having at least three Stouffville players on the roster," said Stavro.

He said the team will announce the names of the local players later this summer.

Stavro said the team will announce the signing of a top 14-year-old future pro prospect from Toronto next week.

The team is offering one third off season tickets until Aug. 31. The price of 24 home dates will be \$99 for adults, \$49 for students 13 to 18 and \$15 for children under 13.

Seniors 65 and over are free. Season ticket holders will be given priority option for playoff games as well as for the game with Red Army. Payment should be made to the Stouffville Spirit Junior Hockey Club, 1035 McNicoll Ave., Scarborough, Ont. M1W 3W6.

The team is also looking for billets for five out of town players, as well as volunteers for positions of assistant coach, goalie coach, public address announcer, music director for games, statistician and videographer. Contact Stavro at 770-3771.
