The convenience store was entered and approximately 70 Penthouse and Playboy magazines were taken. Police said the value of the magazines is estimated at \$420. Damage to the store was about \$400. the disc jockey booth at a Stouffville tavern Friday. York Region police are investigating the disappearance of the case which contained 250 compact discs from Ricki's East Tavern on 10th Line. The CDs went missing sometime between 1 a.m. and 4 p.m. Friday.

Factory entered The Tileist Foot Joy factory on Cardico Dr. in Stouffville was broken into last week. York Region police report the factory was entered at about 11:30 p.m. last Wednesday. An unknown amount of items were taken, and damage was estimated at \$300.
