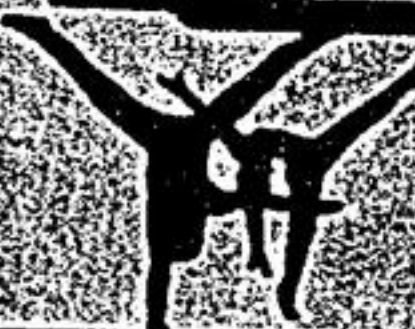

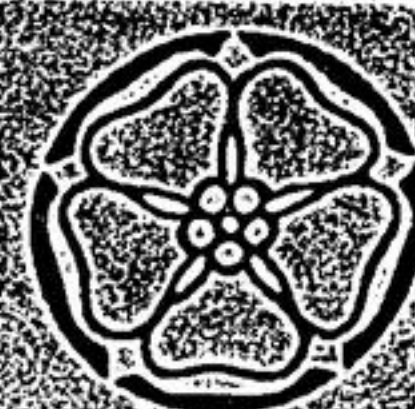

3. By FAX - (General Interest Only) Using VISA call 905-731-8894. Last day to register by FAX is September 11, 1995.

Subject to adequate registration, a wide variety of courses, both credit and general interest, will be offered. For details, please refer to the brochure which was recently distributed with all York Region local papers, Secondary schools, public libraries or community centres in York Region. The brochure lists courses for September and January; please keep for future reference.

Courses for driver education, adult basic literacy, citizenship, and programs for mentally handicapped adults are also offered. Day and evening classes for English as a Second Language will be held in various centres.
