

# Mysterious Ottawa death examined in fascinating book

In 1976, Anne Broder, 36, was found near death in the bathtub of her suburban Ottawa home.

She died hours later in hospital. As police investigated, the "accidental" death began to look more and more like homicide, with the deceased's philandering, pathological liar husband

the prime suspect. However, a major stumbling block arose during the investigation and trial proceedings: no one, expert or otherwise, could say with certainty exactly how the woman died.

Canvassers from Stouffville are being asked to contribute about two hours of their time to the September campaign.

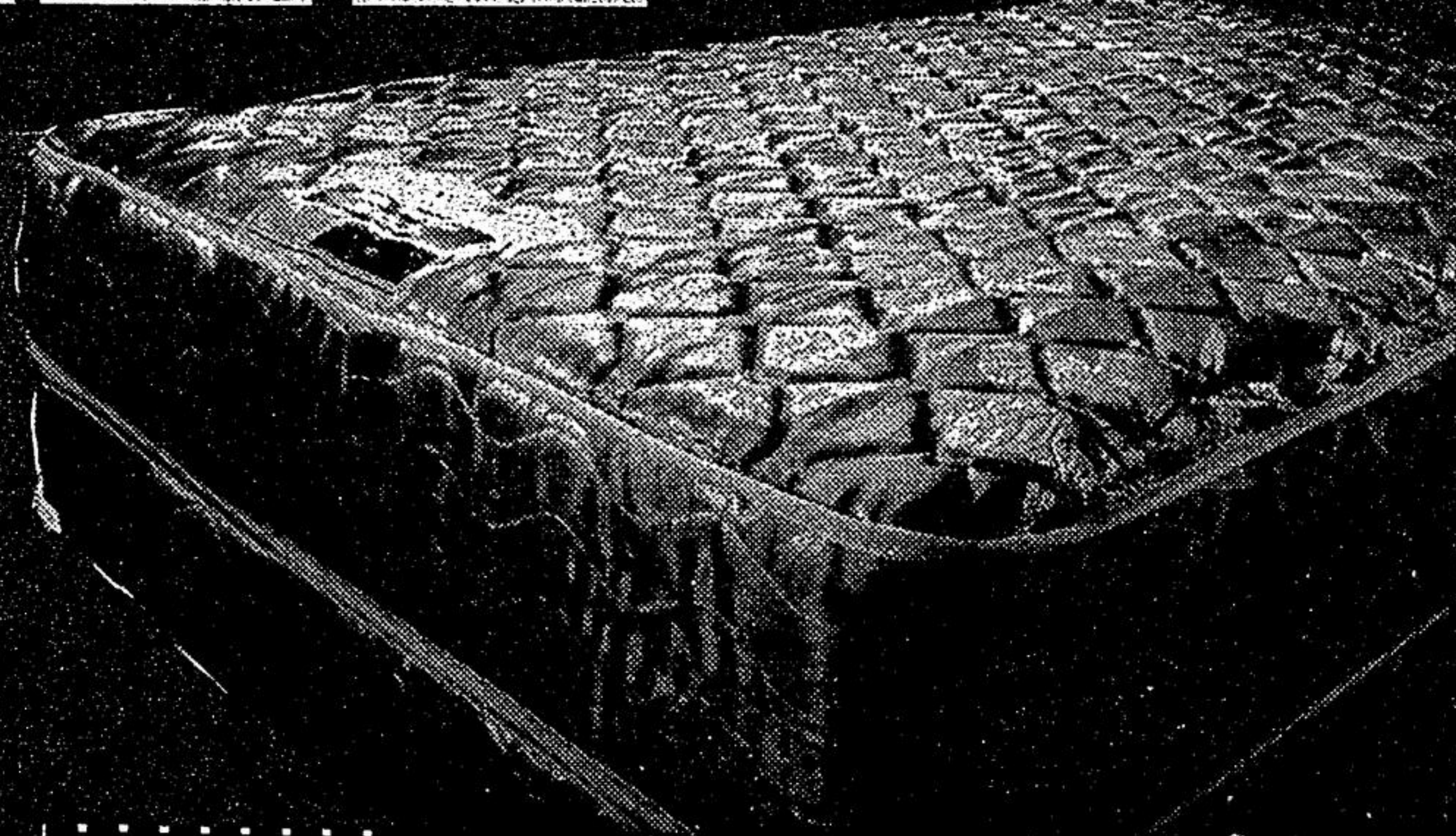
Stouffville residents are also being reminded that arthritis costs Canadians \$10 million in health care costs.
