

# Stouffville recycling depot searching for volunteers

A search has been launched for more volunteers for the local recycling depot in downtown Stouffville.

In a newsletter, published by the Whitchurch-Stouffville Recycling Depot Group, Stephen Sword, group spokesman, pointed out that the depot, located on Park Drive, provides an important service to the community.

The depot diverts literally "tons of material" each month from landfill, said Sword.

With improved markets for recycled goods, the town receives "a return on much of this material which is used to

offset some of the costs of the waste management program," Sword added.

The mixed paper recycled at the depot provides the local group with some income, generating funds to do 3-Rs promotion as well as offering programs to the community.

The local group needs new volun-

teers "to spread the work around," said Sword.

To make volunteering as easy as possible, group officials have posted a four-month calendar at the depot. "People can sign up when they're dropping off recycling materials," said Sword.

Volunteers show people where to place their recycled items.

"Sometimes energetic volunteers climb in to the bins in order to rearrange the material," said Sword.
