Cameras may be option in fight against vandals

Dear Editor,
As I drove to pick-up a newspaper on Saturday morning I observed with both a degree of sadness and a degree of anger, the scars of more vandalism in our community.

Two trees in the Thicketwood/Memorial Park area had been killed, their trunks had been snapped in half and the Burkholder/Park St. sign had been broken off at the base.

I also observed that a number of the large concrete waste receptacles on Main St. had been overturned, the garbage strewn across the sidewalk and street.

On Sunday, I read with interest two articles from the Star and Sun newspa-

pers and could not help but think that they speak to options and elements with respect to rising crime in our community. One of the articles contains an interesting and insightful perspective regarding teens and their responsibility to society from Dear Abby in the Toronto Sun.

The second article from Sunday's Toronto Star refers to the use, by some communities, of closed circuit television, as a cost effective alternative to more police, as a means of controlling and reducing crime. (Perhaps a few well placed security cameras along Main St. and in Memorial Park, might be an option in Stouffville. The cameras could be monitored by citizen volunteers.)

In any event, their content might serve as a catalyst for more discussion and dialogue in the community and may lead to some meaningful action/response.
